Classes- Age as at 1st Jan 2026

- 1 Beanie **BIATHLON** (under 8yrs) Beanbag throw, run 500m
- 2 Beanie **TRIATHLON** (under 8yrs) Beanbag Throw, swim 2 min, run 500m
- 3 Tadpole Girls 9yrs and under Shoot two handed, static 7m, swim 2min, run 1000m
- 4 Tadpole Boys 9yrs and under Shoot two handed, static 7m, swim 2min, run 1000m
- 5 Minimus Girls 11yrs and under Shoot two handed, turning 7m, swim 2min, run 1000m
- 6 Minimus Boys 11yrs and under Shoot two handed, turning 7m, swim 2min, run 1000m
- 7 Junior Girls 14yrs and under Shoot one handed, turning 7m, swim 3min, run 1500m
- 8 Junior Boys 14yrs and under Shoot one handed, turning 7m, swim 3min, run 1500m
- 9 Open Girls 25yrs and under Shoot one handed, turning 10m, swim 3min, run 1500m
- 10 Open Boys 25yrs and under Shoot one handed, turning 10m, swim 4min, run 2000m
- 11 Geriathlon (over 25yrs, team of 2/3 or individual) Shoot one handed, turning 7m, swim 2 min, run 1000m. Each team member may take part in 1, 2 or 3 of the competition phases and scores will be combined. Each participant must be fully versed in the rules of that phase and are responsible for their own insurance cover.

IMPORTANT: ANYONE under 18yrs MUST NOT CARRY GUNS, unless supervised by an adult over 21

Team Competition. To be organised dependant on entries.
