PRE-NOVICE CLASS

Definition of **PRE-NOVICE**. Ridden Horses must be 4 yrs old and over and will be judged as a riding horse. The judge will NOT ride. A short individual show will be required. 4 year olds to wear ordinary snaffle bridle and bit. A Pre Novice horse is one that has not been placed 1st more than two times at an affiliated show. Horses entered in Pre Novice classes may not enter Open classes at the same show. Pre Novice classes are not qualifiers for any championships. Being placed first in a Pre Novice class does not change the Novice status of a horse. Spurs will not be worn in Novice or Pre Novice classes.

TSR THE SHOWING REGISTER

This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales, South West and Scotland. You do not have to be a TSR

member to qualify or enter a final. The rider/handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals. 1 st

and 2 riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring for TSR Rider Final. The two highest placed handlers with a TSR In Hand card will qualify in any in hand class. Handlers must have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward. Cards are available free from the TSR website. Full details at www.theshowingregister.co.uk. TSR members can collect qualification cards and signatures and redeem for a TSR medal – see TSR website for details. With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Championships at Addington Equestrian Centre. You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. CREAM OF THE CROP

The British Palomino Society are again running an exciting championship series open to all horses who have a cream diluted colour, eg cremello, buckskin, palomino, lemon and white, perlino, palomino spotted etc. "BPS Cream of the Crop Championships". The two highest placed in each class will qualify. The series and final will be open to all; there is no need for membership or registration with the BPS. Qualification is simple. The two highest placed cream dilutes in the qualifying class go through to the final (please note horses that are true duns are not eligible as they are not a c ream dilute). The final will be held at the BPS National Championships at the Three Counties Showground in 2018. Qualifiers after this will go forward to the 2019 final.

SHOW RULES AND CONDITIONS – WESSEX AUTUMN SHOW 2017 A COPY OF THE AHS REGISTRATION DOCUMENT MUST BE ENCLOSED WITH ALL ENTRY FORMS

 This show is affiliated to The Arab Horse Society and will be subject to the current Show Rules and Regulations. A copy is held with the Show Secretary or can be downloaded from the relevant society's website details are on the front of this schedule.

- 2) Objections under AHS Rules must be made in writing and submitted to the Show Secretary within one hour of the end of the class or the occurrence and accompanied by the deposit of £50.00 (fifty pounds). For further details, please refer to the AHS Rules for Showing.
- 3) All exhibits must be registered with the AHS in the appropriate section by the closing date of entries.
- 4) Entries with a postmark of after 26 September2017 will only be accepted if the class is NOT full and if accompanied by a late entry fee of £5.00 for the first class entered. Late entries may not appear in the show catalogue.
- 5) The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 6) The Show Committee may at their discretion, cancel, split or amalgamate any class/es.
- 7) All perpetual challenge trophies MUST be returned to the Show Secretary at least one month prior to the following years show. Failure to do so may result in the exhibitor not being permitted to exhibit at future shows. Non members may be required to leave a deposit before removing a trophy.
- 8) No entry fees will be refunded unless a class is cancelled or on production of a valid Veterinary Certificate.
- 9) The judge's decision in all cases will be final. He/she may withhold any award if there is not sufficient merit.
- 10) The Show Committee reserves the right to arrange for replacement or substitute judge if necessary.
- 11) All communication by any exhibitor to a judge must be via the appropriate steward.
- 12) No horse or rider may leave the ring without first obtaining the permission of the judge.
- 13) Any horse behaving in a dangerous manner may be asked to leave the showground.
- 14) All stallions and colts aged 3 years and over must wear secure bridles.
- 15) All handlers are asked to wear traditional English dress.
- 16) No claim for anything that may happen to onlookers, exhibitors, owners, agents, their servants, horses or property, in connection with, or arising out of this show, or conduct or management thereof, will be recognised. Further, exhibitors must indemnify the Show Committee against all actions, costs, claims, demands or liability arising out of any action in which he or she may be concerned.
- 17) No person shall be mounted on the showground unless he/she is wearing a correctly fitting hard hat.
- 18) Unattended horses and ponies must not be left tied to the outside of any vehicle.
- 19) No dogs on the showground.
- 20) Anyone noticing an incident of neglect or ill treatment must report this to the Show Secretary /Steward immediately.
- 21) All horses/ponies entered in any ridden class must be aged 4 years and over.
- 22) A novice horse is one that has not been placed 1st 3 times (prior to the start of the current season) and has never qualified for HOYS. Horses competing in the UK for their first season under saddle are only deemed a novice if they have not been ridden in open classes abroad.
- 23) In the event of the Show having to be cancelled The Wessex Arab Horse Group reserve the right to withhold 25% of entry fees paid to cover expenses.
- 24) An exhibitor whose cheque for entry fees etc. fail to clear when presented for payment will be required to pay all outstanding Monies and any incurred charges before being allowed to compete. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse future show entries from that exhibitor.
- 25) British Arabian Championships eligibility of part breds should have 12.5% pure blood to complete. Anglo Arabs carry the blood of Arab and Thoroughbred only in any proportion.
- 26) Class times will only be given for the first class of each section/session, and exhibitors will be notified of any changes following receipt of entries. Classes will not start before these times unless all entries are present. Competitors are strongly advised to arrive early and watch the progression of classes for themselves. Exhibitors are responsible for being on time for their classes.
- 27) Numbers should be collected from the Show secretary on the day of the show. THEY WILL NOT BE POSTED. If you have provided an email address on your entry form, then you will be emailed with a confirmation of receipt of your entry, also any changes to the timetable will be notified via email or telephone. Providing the relevant contact details will ensure that we can notify of the changes.
- 28) Condition of entry Classes 8 and 9 To quality for entry into these classes the exhibitor must send in a copy of a Heritage Certificate which shows 75% or above Crabbet breeding and issued by the Crabbet Organisation or a letter from Caroline Sussex (Secretary) confirming that the horses entered have 75%+ Crabbet. If the Certificate states that the horse is under 75% Crabbet breeding or there is no letter the entry should be refused and returned to the exhibitor. (Any queries should be directed to Caroline Sussex by fax (01264 738133 or e-mail: Binleystud@aol.com).
- 29) Rules for showing Classes 8 and 9 all horses forward MUST be shown in a natural manner. The pose must be natural, i.e. fore feet together and one hind leg slightly behind the other. The head should be held with the neck showing natural arch and curve of throat line, muzzle would be in line with a point around six eight inches below the wither. The horse should be trained to stand quietly in this position with expression of interest in the handler. Any unnatural posing, flicking with a whip or circling when being run out, will result in the horse being judged as though no presentation or display had been possible and therefore penalised accordingly.
- 30) Any person or persons on the showground behaving in a rude, abusive or dangerous manner likely to compromise the health and safety and the enjoyment of anyone attending the show may be asked to leave the showground.
- 31) Young Handlers/Riders Persons responsible for handlers/riders under the age of 18 must ensure that they are capable of controlling their exhibits. Age and ability must be taken into consideration when pairing handlers/riders to exhibits to ensure their safety and the safety of others.
- 32) Any person or persons who are on the showground for any reason whatsoever, either before, during or after the show is deemed to have agreed to abide by the Wessex Arab Horse Group Summer Show Rules and Conditions 2017.
