Ring 1 – 8AM START

Judge – Cassie Helliwell

Class 1 - BSPS Mixed Height Novice Show Hunter Pony NOT exceeding 153 cm.
Mare or gelding 4 years old and over. Riders must be the correct age for their
ponies.

Class 2 - BSPS Open Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 3 - BSPS Open Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 122cms and not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 4 - BSPS Open Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 5 - BSPS Open Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

BSPS OPEN SHP CHAMPIONSHIP – OPEN TO 1ST PRIZE WINNERS ONLY!

Class 6 - BSPS Open Leading Rein Pony of Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable for riders not to have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in current year. (see regulations for this class regarding leaders)

Class 7 - BSPS Open First Pony of Show Hunter Type/ Show pony. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Snaffle bridles only. No cantering is allowed except for individual performances. Ponies must leave the ring at walk or trot. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

BSPS MINI SHP CHAMPIONSHIP – OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 8 - BSPS Open Intermediate Show Hunter. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 9 - BSPS Novice Intermediate SRT/HT. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 10 - BSPS Mixed Height Open Intermediate Show Riding Type exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

BSPS INTERMEDIATE CHAMPIONSHIP – OPEN TO 1ST PRIZE WINNERS ONLY!

Class 11 - Horse class – Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exc 148 cm. Rider any age. This is open to Hacks, Cobs, Riding Horses and Horses will NOT be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short show.

Class 12 - BSPS Novice First Ridden Pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year

Class 13 - BSPS Leading Rein Pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before the 1st January in the current year

Class 14 - BSPS First Ridden Pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year

BSPS MINI CHAMPIONSHIP – OPEN TO 1ST PRIZE WINNERS ONLY!

Class 15 – BSPS Mixed Height Novice Show Pony NOT exceeding 148cm cm. Mare or gelding 4 years old and over. Riders must be the correct age for their ponies.

Class 16 - BSPS Open Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 17 - BSPS Open Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 15th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 18 - BSPS Open Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

BSPS OPEN SHOW PONY CHAMPIONSHIP – OPEN TO 1ST PRIZE WINNERS ONLY!

Class 19 – Mixed Type Coloured. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over. Horse or Pony – any height. Riders any age.

Class 20 - BSPS Heritage Open Lead Rein. Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 21 - BSPS Heritage Open First Ridden. Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

BSPS HERITAGE MINI CHAMPIONSHIP –OPEN TO 1st AND 2nd PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 22 - BSPS Novice Ridden Small Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland ,Welsh A and Welsh B. Ponies 4 yrs old and over .Riders any age.

Class 23 - BSPS Novice Ridden Large Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Connemara, Dales ,Fell, Highland ,New Forest ,Welsh C and D. Riders any age.

BSPS HERITAGE NOVICE CHAMPIONSHIP – OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 24 - BSPS OPEN Ridden Small Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland ,Welsh A and Welsh B. Ponies 4 yrs old and over .Riders any age.

Class 25 - BSPS OPEN Ridden Large Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Connemara, Dales ,Fell, Highland ,New Forest ,Welsh C and D. Riders any age.

BSPS HERITAGE OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP – OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 26 – BSPS Heritage Young Riders (Small Breeds) – Suitable for Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, welsh section A and B. Mare or gelding exceeding 4 years old and over. Suitable for a rider not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January.

Class 27 – BSPS Heritage Young Riders (Large Breeds) – Suitable for Registered pure breed Connemara, dales, fell, highland, new forest, welsh section C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding exceeding 4 years old and over. Suitable for a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January.

Whilst NOT competing please REMAIN IN YOUR LORRY/CAR.

You will have to create your own number. You will be contacted prior to the show with your allocated number.

Only 3 people per horse/pony are allowed at the show.

- Entries at this training show are limited to 5 per class
- Entries are £15 per class

- A timetable will be produced once the entries are closed – there will be specific times for each class and very specific working in times.
- Do NOT arrive any sonner than 1hour before your class, this allows plenty of time to tack up and warm up.

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY GUIDELINES FOR EXHIBITORS/MEMBERS AT SHOWS

THE SOCIETY EXPECTS EACH MEMBER/EXHIBITOR TO TAKE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR NOT SPREADING THE COVID-19 VIRUS AND OBEYING ALL RULES REGARDING SOCIAL DISTANCING. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE SHOWGROUND.

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE SHOW IF YOU ARE CLASSIFIED AS BEING IN A VULNERABLE CATEGORY AS PER GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES.

EVENTS WILL ONLY TAKE PLACE WHEN GOVERNMENT GUIDANCE ALLOWS THEM TO DO SO

- a) **DO NOT ATTEND IF YOU ARE DISPLAYING THE CORONAVIRUS SYMPTOMS**
- b) Social distance from members other than your family group by 2 metres (or current government guidelines.)
- c) Must use hand sanitisers on regular basis.
- d) Wash hands thoroughly on arrival and after using any facilities and throughout the day.
- e) Use lorry toilets where possible to minimise the risk.
- f) Obey orders given by loudspeaker system regarding social distancing.

- k) **ONLY ANIMALS COMPETING AT THE SHOW BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOWGROUND.**
- l) Show Organisers have taken responsibility to set safeguards in place for exhibitors but attendance at the Show is at your own risk.
