Class 1 – Training Stakes – 40cm Pony any height and rider any age.

Class 2 – BSPS Tiny Tots Stakes. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Open to plaited or unplaited ponies.

Class 3 - BSPS Cradle Stakes. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. This is not a Winter qualifying class. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 4 - BSPS Open Nursery Stakes. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

MINI WHP CHAMPIONSHIP - 1st PRIZEWINNERS FROM CLASSES 2,3 AND 4

Class 5 - BSPS Novice 133cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 6 - BSPS Open 133cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 7 - BSPS Novice 143cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 8 - BSPS Open 143cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 9 - BSPS Novice 153cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 10 - BSPS Open 153cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 11 - BSPS Novice Intermediate WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 12 - BSPS Open Intermediate WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 15 - BSPS Novice Heritage WHP. Mixed Height Registered pure bred ponies 4 yrs old or over. Rider any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one animal providing they are in different height sections.

Class 16 - BSPS Open Heritage WHP. Mixed Height Registered pure bred ponies 4 yrs old or over. Rider any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one animal providing they are in different height sections.

You will have to create your own number. You will be contacted prior to the show with your allocated number and a more detailed timetable with not before times on it.

Only 3 people per horse/pony are allowed at the show.

NO SPECTATORS OR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
