



## BREARTON FUN RIDE



### **BANK HOLIDAY MONDAY 31st AUGUST 2020**

Come and join us for a great day riding in the beautiful countryside of the Mountgarret Estate, a few miles north of Harrogate and Knaresborough.

There have been very few horse events this summer and, for those of us looking to start Autumn Hunting in September, it is a great opportunity to get your horse fit. Even if you don't "follow the hounds", your horse will benefit and you will enjoy the relaxed ride away from the cares of the day and the traffic.

The ride starts and finishes near Brearton. The ride is about 10 miles, entirely within the Mountgarret Estate, with only a few hundred yards on a minor public road, and with optional jumps. The jumps are easily avoided if you are a non-jumper. A shorter route of about 5 miles can be taken. The ride will be well signposted and maps will be available online and also from the Event Secretary. Riders, alone or in small groups, may start the ride between 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon and are expected to return by 2.30 p.m.

Parking will be signposted on the day of the ride. Download What3Words from the AppStore to find the event. The What3Words code is pulps.landscape.dancer.

The cost is £25 per rider, £15 for youngsters under 12. Children must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

**Due to COVID-19 we cannot, this year, accept cash or entries on the day of the ride. Also, we will not be able to provide catering at the event. However, bottles of water will be available (at no charge) at the halfway point and at the finish of the ride.**

**Please conform to all social distancing and other requirements under the Government's COVID-19 guidelines in the parking area and on the ride. Anyone under isolation or quarantine or with COVID-19 symptoms or from a lockdown area should not attend.**

**Please read the rules of the event, by entering you are agreeing to adhere to these rules.**

#### RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Riders (and their ground crew and/or drivers) must abide by Government COVID-19 regulations whilst at the event and on the ride. Hand sanitiser will be available near the Event Secretary. Keep yourself safe; use it. Wash/ sanitise your hands regularly and especially after touching something that has been touched by other people. Face masks are at the individual's discretion.
- Entries are not refundable.
- All riders must report to the Event Secretary on arrival. Their names will be checked with the entry list and a ticket/sticker for the ride will be provided for each rider. This sticker must be displayed on the left side of the riding hat before starting on the ride. Riders must have this sticker to join the ride.
- Ensure you have appropriate equipment and clothing. Hard hats are compulsory and body protectors are recommended if jumping.
- Riding horses is a high-risk sport and riders taking part in this ride acknowledge this and do so at their own risk. Neither the landowners nor the organisers nor anyone acting on their behalf accepts responsibility for loss, damage, accident, illness or injury to ponies, horses, riders and spectators or their property. Everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.
- All riders must have 3rd party liability insurance.
- Good riding manners are requested at all times. Riders should take note of ground conditions and ride at an appropriate speed to mitigate the risk of slipping, falling or losing control of their horse/ pony. Riders should be cautious when overtaking others who may be novice riders, or on young horses. Riders should not ride too close to the horse in front when jumping
- The route will be clearly signed and a map will be available, if requested. Riders MUST stick to the marked route.
- If you get lost on the route, please call the number provided. It will be posted near the Event Secretary.
- There will be no catering or refreshments on site available for purchase. Please bring your own food and drinks.
- Anyone (including non-riding support crew) the organisers or stewards believe to be in breach of the Rules and Conditions of Entry will be asked to leave the site immediately and no refund of entry fee will be made.
