Ring 1 (all classes in this ring are for enjoyment and fun) with lovely rosettes. Trophies/Sashes are awarded in some classes: Start 10am

Class 1: **Young stock in hand.** Open to all breeds and types 4yrs and under. Please bring passport as proof of age. Sponsored by Heathlands Animal Sanctuary *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 2: **Ridden Cobs** - open to all horses and ponies. Individual show required. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 3: **Best Condition in hand**. Open to stabled and grass kept horses/ponies. Sponsored by Hertford Horsebits

Class 4: **Coloureds in hand** open to all coloureds/odd coloureds including duns, palominos, skewbald, piebald, roans. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 5: **Ridden Mountain & Moorland** open to any pure and part bred M & M horse or pony. Individual show required. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 6: **Heavy horses/Driving types in hand** – open to any horse/pony true to type. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 7: not before 1pm Fancy Dress - open to children under the age of 14yrs, additional marks for hand-made costumes and accessories.

Class 8: **Ridden coloureds/odd coloureds** - open to all coloureds/odd coloureds including duns, palominos, skewbald, piebald, roans. Individual show required. Sponsored by Shepherd Equine. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 9: Foreign breeds in hand open to mixed breeds – Warmbloods, Arabs & nonnative breeds. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 10: **Best Child handler** open to children under the age of 12yrs. *Royal London Qualifier*

<u>Ring 2 all classes in this ring are for enjoyment and fun) with lovely rosettes</u> Class 10: Clear round show jumping (every clear round wins a rosette, we are unable to change height of fences once class commences, please be at the ring at the allocated times) Entries taken on the day

Section A <u>10.30am-11.30pm</u> cross poles (suitable for contessa clients) Can be lead rein Section B 11.30am - 12.30pm 60 cm Class 11: **Novice Fun jumping** Maximum height **70cm**. Run as single phase (timed from fence 6 onwards) £10. Sponsored by Kathryn Muir

<u>Ring 3 (all classes in this ring are for enjoyment and fun) with lovely rosettes.</u> <u>Trophies/sashes are awarded in some classes: Start 10 am</u>

Class 12: Lead Rein – Any suitable horse or pony suitable as a lead rein. Riders 10 yrs and under in a snaffle bit, lead rein to be attached to noseband. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 13: **Veterans in hand** open to all horses and ponies over 15yrs. Please bring passport as proof of age. Classes may be split according to 15-21yrs & 21yrs + if sufficient entries. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 14: **Ridden Pony Club Pony**, open to suitable pony club ponies to include a jump and individual show. Sponsored by Easy Horsemanship

Class 15: **Ridden Veterans** open to all horses and ponies over 15yrs. Please bring passport as proof of age. Individual show required. Classes may be split according to age 15-21yrs & 21yrs + if sufficient entries. *Royal London Qualifier*

Class 16: **Most handsome Gelding in hand**. Open to all stabled and grass kept horses/ponies. Sponsored by Lyn Byatt in memory of Benji.

Class 17 Prettiest mare in hand. Open to all stabled and grass kept horses/ponies.

Class 18: not before 1.45pm In hand Horse or pony judge would most like to take home – judged on manners, appearance and in hand show.

Class 19: **Ideal Partners** – open to horse/ponies judged on manners, performance and compatibility with rider. Sponsored by Fernside Veterinary Centre

Class 20: **Ridden Dressage/Potential Dressage Horse.** Open to all levels from Prelim to Advanced judged on correctness of way of going for level of horse. Individual show required. Sponsored by Annie Pye.

Show rules & entry fees:

• Online entries **Closing date Wednesday 1st August 5pm.** All pre- entered showing £8 per class or 2 showing classes for £15. Clear round £6 per class or 2 for £10

before closing date by online entry system or cash payment at Contessa Riding Centre in Person. Cheques not accepted.

- Entries after close of entry or **on day £10 per class.** Cash only accepted on the day. On the day entries will close 10 minutes before the class is due to start.
- Contessa clients £20 per showing class. Entries in advance for Contessa horses.
- <u>Please be aware we have designated first aider's on the premises plus basic fist</u> <u>aid equipment. We will not have paramedic cover on site on the day. By</u> <u>entering this show you accept this risk.</u>

 - 1. Judges decision is final.
 - 2. Arena sizes and surfaces will vary, please be aware grass arenas and warm up may be on un-level ground. Arenas may be grass or surfaced.
 - 3. No dogs allowed on show ground.

4. Riding hats to PAS 015, ASTM F1163, BSEN 1384* and SNELL E2001 and correct footwear must be worn at all time while mounted. Body protectors are advisable for riding & jumping, but all competitors ride at their own risk.

- 5. All ridden horses/ponies must be at least 4yrs old, sound and disease free and must hold 3rd party liability insurance.
- 6. Organisers will not be held responsible for any horse/ spectator or property injured/damaged while on premises during the Show hours.
- 7. Any Colts or Stallions must be shown bitted with the appropriate Yellow tail ribbon in place.
- 8. All non ridden horses must be sound and disease free.
- 9. All reasonable steps will be taken by Contessa R.C to ensure your safety, however all spectators, riders and handlers attend the show at their own risk. Please see above regarding first aid cover.
- 10.No refunds will be given on the day.
- 11.Refunds will only be given with a vet's certificate presented within 1 week of the event less an admin fee of £3 per class.
- 12. This show is run by staff and volunteers please be courteous to all, it is designed to be a fun day for all.
- 13.Classes where returnable trophies are awarded require a refundable deposit of £20, for competitors who wish to hold the trophy for a year.
- 14. In the event of cancellation by Contessa Riding Centre due to unforeseen circumstances you will be notified via Facebook/Contessa website. Entry fees will be refunded.
- 15.All spectators and riders must remain in designated areas as instructed by Stewards.
- 16. Competitors are deemed to accept these rules on placing their entry.

17. The organiser has the right to alter which arena classes are held in on the day to accommodate additional entries or weather conditions. All times are approximate and will vary according to entries on the day.
