The correct standard of hat must be worn with a chin strap at all times when mounted.

Horses/ponies under the age of 4 years must not be ridden on the showground.

Dogs must be kept on a lead.

No mucking out of horseboxes on the showground.

Please take your rubbish home with you or use the bins provided – horses will be turned out in the fields the day after show.

Stallions/ colts welcome but must be handled by competent person

All complaints must be made in writing and accompanied by £15.00 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.

Refunds are only given if we cancel a class, we do not give refunds if a competitor withdraws from a class.
