The event will be run under the general rules of British Eventing and offers competitors the opportunity of undertaking three phases of competition at BE level. The cross-country sections will, as usual, be untimed but the optimum times will be posted, and riders will be able to use stopwatches if they wish.

THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO SENIOR AND JUNIOR RIDERS.

Class 1 - 80cm - Equivalent to BE80T – All phases on Sunday. **Horses must not have competed above BE90.** **Open to Senior and Junior riders.**

Dressage Test BE90 Dressage Test (2009) The Show Jumping and Cross Country for this Section will be approximately 80cm.

Class 2 - 90cm - Equivalent to BE90 – All Phases on Sunday. **Open to Senior and Junior riders.**

Dressage Test BE 90 Dressage Test (2016) The Show Jumping and Cross Country in this section will be approximately 90 - 95cm.

Class 3 - 100CM - Equivalent to BE 100 - All phases on Sunday. **Open to Senior and Junior riders**

Dressage Test BE 100 Dressage Test (2010) The Show Jumping and Cross Country in this Section will be approximately 1.00 - 1.05m.

ALL CLASSES ARE OPEN TO MEMBERS AND NON-MEMBERS. JUNIORS AND SENIORS.

Entry Fee - £60.00 FOR ALL CLASSES. There will be a **starting fee of £5.00 payable when you enter.** Online entries will be taken on www.horseevents.co.uk including online payment by credit or debit card.

Entries will open on Friday 22nd April 2022 - Entries will close at 12 noon on Thursday 9th June 2022, or before if the classes are full. An up-to-date list of entries by class will appear on the website www.horseevents.co.uk. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IF SPACE PERMITS.

A Wait list will be maintained, and full details will be posted on the www.horseevents.co.uk website, as will be names of competitors whose entries have been accepted. Competitors are advised to check the website regularly.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR COMPETITORS

Medical Armbands & Hat Tags

For insurance purposes **ALL** competitors **MUST** wear a medical armband despite this no longer being a BE rule and **ALL** hats must be tagged with an up-to-date BE/BRC/PC tag **Colour Aqua**. (If you are unsure or if your hat is not tagged, please bring your hat with you to the secretaries tent).

Number Bibs

Competitors will be expected to print their own number (A4 size) to be inserted into the transparent pockets of a British Eventing type number bib. A template for these will be available at both www.horse-events.co.uk / www.eventingscores.co.uk. ***Competitors will be expected to purchase their own number bibs prior to the event.***

Multiple Entries

In order that as many competitors as possible are given the chance to compete, riders will be restricted to a maximum of *three entries each and only two per class*. *Should space be available after entries have closed and there is no waitlist then riders will be permitted additional entries on top of their limited three entries*. Experience has shown that the Novice sections fill up well ahead of the Open sections. All entries are taken on a purely first come, first served basis, so competitors are advised to send their entries in early.

Location - The entrance for the Event for *ALL* officials, competitors and spectators is off the A619 Worksop Road. Competitors from the M1 should leave at Junction 30. Sat Nav postcode is S43 4TA

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Novice restriction. Horses with British Eventing Grading points are ineligible for Class 1 - Foundation points are allowed.*
- 2. In the event of a tie the places will be decided on the highest number of Collective Dressage marks and if there is still a tie then the closest to the optimum time in the Show Jumping.*
- 3. Horses must be a minimum of 5 years old during the year of the competition.*
- 4. SAE will be accepted for any dressage score sheets please hand in to the event secretary with rider number and section on the back.*
