RULES

Horses/Ponies must be 4 years of age or older

Riders must be 10 years of age for PN. - There is no age limit for Intro

British Eventing Points do not apply to unaffiliated events at Horseheath.

Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted to specifications detailed in British Eventing rules.

Body Protectors must be worn for the cross country phase.

Any horse or pony, which is considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge or the Organisers will be excluded from further competition without refund of entry fee.

ATV's and motor bikes are not permitted. The competition will be run mainly in conjunction with British Eventing rules

Start fees to be paid in cash at the time of number collection.

Objections

Objections must be made in writing within half an hour of the incident together with a £50 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained

In case of abandonment please call **07825091409.** In the unlikely event of abandonment, entries will be transferred to the next unaffiliated event. Competitors who are able to provide a helper will be given priority – please add your helper details in the 'Special Requests' section of the entry form. Horseheath welcomes dogs BUT they must be kept on a lead at all times and dog waste must be picked up and placed in a bin. Paper numbers will be used, so please do make sure that you have a bib (Tiggas Tack Shop will be on site for purchase on the day)

Horse or Rider substitutions will be accepted at the cost of £12, horse and rider substitutions will NOT be accepted

- It is compulsory that all riders wear hats/helmets up to British Standard Riding Hats
- Body protectors MUST be worn
- All horses must be vaccinated following the British Eventing 12 month ruling
- It is compulsory that every person entering upon the Horse-Events venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Please do **not** muck out your horsebox on site.
- The Management of the venue reserves the right to remove anyone from the course at any time without giving a reason.
- You note and accept there will be a paramedic, technician, doctor and 4x4 ambulance vehicle on site.
- A vet and a farrier will be present at the event
- The Event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the facebook Horseheath HorseTrials page.
- All horses/ponies must be 4 years and over.
