Qualified members for Junior Series need to pre-enter the final by post – closing date Wednesday 14th October 2015

Pre-entries online www.horsevents.co.uk or ENTRIES ON THE DAY (Cash only) for Classes 1, 3, 5, and 7.

WARM UP CLASSES (1,3,5,& /7) are open to ALL.

Area 3 Junior Series – classes 2, 4 and 6 are FINALS for the Junior Series. Only open to qualified teams and individuals entry by post only. All classes will be Two Phase competitions;

Class 1: Warm up class open to all – 40cms max 1st round. Two phase competition.

Class 2: Junior Series Final - 10 yrs and under – 60cms max 1st round. Timed fences 8-13 - 70cms max.

Class 3: Warm up class open to all – 65cms max in first round – two phase competition

Class 4: Junior Series Final - 12 yrs and under – 70cms max 1st round. Timed fences 8-13 - 75cms max.

Class 5: Warm up class open to all – 75cms max in first round – two phase competition.

Class 6: Junior Series -12 yrs and under – 80cms max 1st round. Timed fences 8-13 - 85cms max.

Class 7: -90 cms Open including Dengie Winter League Preliminary Qualifying round for eligible entrants, two phase competition.

Entry fee: £12 per competitor per class.

Rosettes to 6th place for all classes.

Prizes, rosettes and sashes to winning teams and individuals for the Junior Series

To be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2015.

Hard hats to the required standard must be fastened and worn at all times when mounted. No jewellery allowed. Jackets and ties/stocks to be worn and hair below the collar must be in a hair net.

Owners and riders entering their horse/ponies do so at their own risk. The Middleton Hunt Pony Club Officers and Members and the Landowners will accept no liability of any kind in respect of any loss, damage or accident to horse, rider, spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.

The organisers of this event have taken every responsible precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, members of the public and all competitors must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must comply with the organisers, officials and stewards.

The decision of the judges is final. Any objections should be made within 15 minutes of the class finishing, together with a deposit of £12. This will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld by the Judges.

Pre-entries for warm up classes 1, 3, 5 and 7 can be made using www.horsevents.co.uk - £12 per Class or on the day – no postal entries.

All stewards, helpers and organisers are volunteers and we would please ask that you treat them with respect at all times.
