RING 1 - Judge: Mrs E Tate

9am-10am: Clear Round

10am: Working Hunter Classes Start

Class 1: On or Off Lead rein.

Riders 9 and under. Ponies max 13hh.

Class 2: Beginner Stakes (assistance permitted), max 45cm. No spreads.

Riders any age, horses any height.

Class 3: Novice (little fillers) 50cm.

Riders any age. Horses any height.

Class 4: Novice (little fillers) 60cm.

Riders any age. Horses any height.

Class 5: Coloured horses. 65cm.

Open to traditional and plaited coloured horses and ponies. Riders any age. Horses any height.

Class 6: M&M small breeds class. 55cm.

Riders any age.

Class 7: M&M large breeds class. 70cm.

Riders any age.

Class 8: Open (all fillers) 70cm.

Riders any age. Horses any height.

Class 9: Open (all fillers) 80cm.

Riders any age. Horses any height.

Class 10: Open (all fillers) 90cm.

Riders any age. Horses any height.

RING 2 - Judge: TBC

9am: Flat Showing Classes Start

Class 11: Lead rein combination.

Ponies max 128cms, riders 9yrs and under.

Class 12: First Ridden

Ponies max 128cms, riders 11yrs and under.

No cantering together.

Class 13: Novice rider.

No cantering together. Canter optional in individual show. Open to all ages and ideal for anyone wishing to gain ridden class confidence.

Class 14: Novice horse/pony.

Horses to be within their first year of competition.

Class 15: Most promising combination.

Open to any type horse/pony under 7 years.

Class 16: Open horse/pony.

Open to any type, any age.

Class 17: TB / Hunter / Sport Horse / Cob

TBs can be raced or unraced, racing blemishes ignored.

Class 18: Coloured

May split if sufficient entries.

Class 19: M&M

May split if sufficient entries.

Class 20: Veteran

Horse/pony 15 years and over.

- The show will be run on grass, weather-permitting.
- Online entries only via Horsevents. Closing date for entries Thursday 15th July. Entry fees are non-returnable.
- Each class entry fee £12.50. Prizes to all class winners.
- Times will be available Friday 16th July.
- Please do not arrive too early and once you have finished your classes please return to your vehicle and leave the showground. Whilst NOT competing please REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE.
- Please create your own number. You will be contacted prior to the show with your allocated number.
