Arena Eventing - £25 per entry

Classes -

80cm: SJ - 325mpm, XC - 375mpm (Purple Disc)

90cm: SJ - 325mpm, XC - 400mpm (Orange Disc)

100cm: SJ - 325mpm, XC - 425mpm (Pink Disc)

Competitors will jump a course of show jumps immediately followed by cross country fences in and around the arena. Class 90 and 100cm will include water

All XC fences will be Spiro fixed down for safety. Clear rounds take precedence over anyone with jumping faults. The winner will be nearest under the optimum time with a clear round in both Show Jumping and Cross Country.

Studs may be worn.

Rosettes to 10th place per class. Prizes in Kind.

Closing date for entries 14th March

Additional £5 charged for Late entry after closing date if numbers allow.

Numbers will be strictly limited so please enter early to avoid disappointment.

Withdrawals to qualify for a refund must be made before the closing date and a £5 admin fee will be charged. There is a £2 contribution towards Medical & Vet cover on collection of numbers.

Body Protectors and Hats of a suitable standard (PAS015 or EN1384) in line with BE & BRC rules, must be worn at all times when mounted.
