A relaxed One Day Event for beginners! Open to all ages, no show dress required, dressage tests may be called & ridden in any bit. Choose to enter either all 3 dressage, Showjumping & XC phases or just dressage & jumping for the combined training competition.

How to enter......

1. Choose your dressage test...

*The Pony Club D level Walk & Trot test 2012 *The Pony Club C level Dressage test 2012

2. Choose your jumping height...

*40cm *60cm *80cm

3. Choose whether entering...

*One Day Event (dressage, showjumping & cross country) *Combined Training (dressage & showjumping)

Classes will be run according to jumping height regardless of which dressage test is chosen.

ONE DAY EVENT: Showjumping & XC will be in 1 ring & run as a showcross approx. 40 mins after dressage time. Approx 8 SJ fences followed immediately by approx. 8 XC fences. Placings decided by the highest dressage score & least jumping/XC faults combined. Juniors & Seniors placed separately.

COMBINED TRAINING: Competitors will jump the Showjumping section of the ODE only, approx. 40 mins after dressage time.

Placings decided by the highest dressage score & least jumping/XC faults combined. Juniors & Seniors placed separately. Rosettes to 6th, prizes to 3rd places in all sections.

Only 1 class per horse/pony may be entered. Competitors with multiple rides welcome.

Dress Code

Traditional dressage wear is not required & ponies/horses do not need to be plaited! Just plain & tidy is what we ask, to the following guidelines....

JODPHURS- Solid colours, no patterns SHIRTS – Sweatshirt/jacket, no hoods please FOOTWEAR – Riding boot/shoe with a suitable heel, no country boots, muck boots or wellingtons GLOVES – Must be worn for dressage, any colour HAT – Suitable riding hat, fixed at more than 2 points & fastened at all times when mounted. See hat rules below. No fixed peak for XC allowed NUMNAHS- Can be of any colour PONIES/HORSES – No plaiting required but please try & be as neat & tidy as possible. Stable stains & yellow tails are fine,

dried, unbrushed mud is not! BODY PROTECTORS - Are compulsory for the XC phase. See rules below

Entries close on Mon 7th August. Times will be text out & published on our facebook page on Thurs 10th August.

Please state when entering if a junior or senior

Conditions of Entry

1. All riders must wear approved protective hard hats, fixed at more than two points. Chinstraps to be fastened at all times when mounted. Hats must conform to current standards that can be found on the PC website.

2. All competitors must be correctly dressed.

3. Objections may be raised by lodging £10 with the Secretary, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

4. Excess cruelty to horse or pony will result in disqualification.

5. Horses and Ponies will be considered to be 'in the charge of the competitors' and the committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury owing to accident or any other cause.

6. We reserve the right to change, cancel or amend any class without prior notice.

LEGAL LIABILITY
