Dressage Test: PC110 Eventing Test 2022.

Open to individuals and teams of three or four Members from each Branch / Centre in Area 3 (best three scores to count in the team competition).

Rosettes: Individual Sections 1st to 6th. Teams 1st to 6th.

ENTRIES

All entries to be done online at horsevents.co.uk.

Entry Fees: Class 1 £70. Classes 2 - 6 £75.

Entries open on 8th June 2022 and close on 5th July 2022.

Late entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion, although this event is usually oversubscribed. Late Entry Surcharge £10.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Queries on the day may only be raised via the Secretary by the DC or their appointee. Protests / objections will be managed as per Rule 5.

No horse will be allowed to compete in 2 classes.

Photographic Rights - competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.

A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials.

Vaccinations must be in accordance with the current Pony Club Eventing Rule listed on The Pony Club website.

WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS

Withdrawals - Withdrawal before close of entries – full refund less booking fee.

After the closing date no refunds will be made unless a Doctor's or Vet's certificate is produced no later than 24 hours after the event. If produced after this no refunds will be given.

Withdrawal between close of entries and before times are issued - 50% refund less booking fee.

No refund after times have been issued.

Substitutions after closing date may be charged a fee.

Before the Closing date you can edit your own booking online to change the horse & rider.

N.B. No refund will be given to those who's entry validation is declined because horse / rider are not eligible for the class. Check with your DC and the rule book before entering.

DRESS AND SADDLERY

You are reminded that it is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their dress and saddlery are in accordance with the rules as set out in The Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2022. Please could all competitors bring their own number bib and print their own paper number.

PRIZES & PRIZE GIVING

Prize giving for each class will be unmounted but members must be correctly turned out with jacket, hat etc. *Thank you to our generous class sponsors and Top Spec for providing rosettes and prizes*.

VET

There will be a vet in attendance. All costs are to be settled directly with the vet.
