- Junior Jumping 1'6" / 45cms Class 3 3A: Under 10 years old 3B: 10 years old and over
- Horse and Hound All Ages Jumps approx. 1' / 30cms Class 4 Horse & Rider then Hound & Rider or Groom to complete course. Fastest clear round wins.

Riders are expected to perform a short individual demonstration of all three paces after all riders have cleared a small jump.

Class 16 Best Rider under 12yrs

No jumping – judged on rider ability, style & correctness

Lead reins not permitted

Riders are expected to perform a short individual demonstration of all three paces

Class 17 Best Rider 12yrs and over

No jumping – judged on rider ability, style & correctness

Lead reins not permitted

Riders are expected to perform a short individual demonstration of all three paces

Class 18 Veteran Horse or Pony – over 15 years

In Hand or Mounted

Class 19 Best Coloured Horse or Pony

In Hand or Mounted

Class 20 Best Handler – In Hand, unmounted, pony unsaddled

Judged on person with best showing and handling of pony


Riders are expected to jump rustic fences and perform a short show with trot, canter on both reins and extension.

- Class 28 Working hunter 14.2 hh and under Jumps not to exceed 2'6" / 75cms
- Class 29 Working hunter 12.2 hh and under Jumps not to exceed 1'9" / 50cms

Showground is close to Hanford School and will be signed from A357 and A350 Please access the site by following the marked route as some the tracks are private.

Please check Portman PC website if poor weather in case of cancellation

Rules:

All riders to be correctly dressed with approved headwear worn by anyone riding at all times. The judges decision shall be final. No horse/pony may compete more than once in any 1 class, except Clear Round and Handy Pony. No horse/pony under 4 years may compete. No stallions on the showground. The committee cannot accept liability for any accident or loss either to competitors, spectators animals, property, vehicles or any other person whatsoever. **Entries are only accepted on this condition**.


The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry made by any person, if they shall deem it right to do so, without giving any reason. Objections must be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £25 which will be refunded if the objection is sustained, within 15 minutes of the alleged incident to the Show Secretary. Competitors entering classes that clash do so at their own risk. The schedule is subject to revision on the day. In the event of insufficient entries being received classes may be cancelled, amalgamated or split. Times could therefore change. Judges may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs. No whips over 30" in length. Anyone galloping or abusing their horse/pony on the Show Ground will be asked to leave. No refund will be given unless a veterinary/doctor certificate is given. Dogs are allowed and MUST be on leads at all times. Please clean up after your dog. Trophies must be returned to Organisers by 1st May 2018. Please remove all litter and droppings. Age to be taken at 1 January 2017
