Class 1 - 09:00 - Richard Thorpe Arena - **Pony Intro 70cm Open**

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 70cm.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 2 - Richard Thorpe Arena - **Stepping Stones 128/138cm Handicap**

Rule 414. Table A6. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 75cm / 85cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with Rules 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all but for qualification purposes, Riders who have ever obtained points on the Gold League are not eligible for the Stepping Stones Final. Pony/Rider combinations who have ever obtained points on the Silver League are also not eligible for the Stepping Stones Final. Qualifies for: Four double clear rounds to qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships. Two double clear rounds will also qualify for Cats & Pipes at The Scope Championship. Qualifying Period: 1st July - 30th June for Stepping Stones. 1st January-31st July for Cats & Pipes. Numbers to qualify: Those pony/rider combinations who achieve four double clears (subject to revision) will qualify for the Final. Those ponies who achieve two double clears will also qualify for the Cats & Pipes Championship at The Scope Championship. If run as a Handicap, pony riders will be given dispensation to ride up to three ponies in each height section. No rider may compete more than three ponies in the same section.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 3 - Richard Thorpe Arena - Springboard 128/138cm Handicap

Rule 415 & 284,. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 85cm / 95cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with Rule 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all but for qualification purposes: • In the 128cms section, Junior riders are eligible to enter, irrespective of points achieved, before the calendar year in which the age of 10 years is reached. Riders who reach the age of 10 years and over in the current calendar year must not have won a total of 500 points. (as of 01.08.2017 pony/rider combination). • In the 138cms section, Junior riders are eligible to enter, irrespective of points achieved, before the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached. Riders who reach the age 12 years and over in the current calendar year must not have won a total of 850 points. (as of 01.08.2017 pony/rider combination). Junior Riders are not eligible to enter the 138cms section until the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached. Ponies 128cm & under are not permitted to enter the 138cm section. Once riders have competed at, or have 'ever' qualified for RIHS or HOYS on any height pony they are no longer eligible to compete in the Final. Pony/rider combinations who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the final of this competition. Qualifies for: Springboard Final. Qualifying Period: 1st February -31st January. Numbers to Qualify: Four double clears to qualify for the Final. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification. In order to compete in the Final, all qualified competitors ages must be in accordance with the Rule 77.12 & 77.13 in the year of the Final. If run as a Handicap, pony riders will be given dispensation to ride up to three ponies in each height section. No rider may compete more than three ponies in the same section.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Rule 514, 512 & 284, . Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.00m / 1.10m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

• 138cm Section: For registered ponies exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms to be ridden by Junior Members (ages in accordance with Rule 77.12). Pony riders are not eligible to compete before the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached. Qualifies for: Winter 138cms Second Round Competition & Horse Of The Year Show 138cm Second Round. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision). • 128cm Section: For registered ponies not exceeding 128cms to be ridden by Junior Members (ages in accordance with Rule 77.13). Junior riders are not eligible to compete before the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached. Qualifies for: Winter 128cms Second Round Competition & Horse Of The Year Show 128cm Second Round. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify (subject to revision). Dispensation will be given to run the Winter 128cms and Winter 138cms First Rounds as a handicap competition. If run as a Handicap, pony riders will be given dispensation to ride up to three ponies in each height section. This class will split in the event of 20 starters or more and two sets of prize money awarded. No rider may ride more than three ponies in the same competition, in accordance with rule 77.6.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 5 - Richard Thorpe Arena - STX-UK Pony British Novice - First Round /80cm Open

Rule 410. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Kindly sponsored by STX-UK Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- **British Novice:**For registered ponies in Grade JD, that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13. Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.
- **80cm Open:**For registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior MembersIf combined with an open:In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 6 - Richard Thorpe Arena - Pony Discovery - First Round/90cm Open

Rule 408. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- **Discovery:**For registered ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 300 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13. Qualifies for: Pony Discovery Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify for: Those ponies which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Discovery First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Pony Discovery Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony Discovery First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.
- **90cm Open:**For registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior MembersIf combined with an open:In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 7 - Richard Thorpe Arena - Pony Newcomers/Pony 1.00m Open (both to inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Qualifier)

Rule 406 & 416. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- **Pony Newcomers** is for registered ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members. Qualifies for: Pony Newcomers Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to

compete in the Pony Newcomers Second Rounds. • The Open Section is for registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. Junior Members, in either the Open or the Newcomers Section who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship. Riders who have ever accrued points on the Pony Gold League up to and including the end of the qualifying period are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final. Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/rider Combination. Ponies may compete in one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Rule 404 & 417. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

Kindly sponsored by STX-UK In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

• Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members. Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Foxhunter First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Pony Foxhunter Second Rounds. • The Open Section is for registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. Junior Members, in either the Open or the Pony Foxhunter Section, who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship. Riders who have ever accrued points on the Pony Gold League up to and including the end of the qualifying period are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 9 - Richard Thorpe Arena - Junior 1.15m & 1.20m Open Handicap

Rule 284. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.15m / 1.20m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by Junior Members. Ponies may compete in one section only. The 1.15m section incorporates the Pony National 1.15m Members Cup Qualifier. Rule 400, those pony/rider combinations that have been placed in a Winter JA Classic or Pony Show Jumper of the Year will not be eligible to compete in the Final at the British Showjumping National Championships in August. Qualifying period: 1 July - 30 June. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify. Qualification is pony/rider combination. The 1.20m section incorporates the 148cm Restricted Open Championship. Rule 399, riders who have ever been on a Pony European Championship team, Pony Nation Cups team or pony/rider combinations in the top 10 of the Gold league as of 31st March 2027 are not eligible to qualify for the Final. The Final will be at the Welsh Home Pony Show. Qualifying period: 1 July - 30 June. Numbers to qualify: Those combinations who jump double clear (clear in the first round and the first jump-off) (one double clear) in the qualifying period. Ponies can only jump one section.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.
