Class 1 - 09:00 - Stainsby Grange Arena - Pony Intro 70cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 70cm. **DRAWN ORDER**

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £18.00, Total: £93.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Dismounted prize giving – mandatory, in accordance with rule 101.7, (top 3 required)

Class 2 - Stainsby Grange Arena - Stepping Stones 128/138cm Handicap

Rule 414. Table A6. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 75cm / 85cm. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with Rules 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all but for qualification purposes, Riders who have ever obtained points in the Gold League are not eligible for the Stepping Stones Final. Pony/Rider combinations who have ever obtained points in the Silver are also not eligible for the Stepping Stones Final. Qualifies for: Four double clear rounds to qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships. Two double clear rounds will also qualify for the Scope Festival. Qualifying Period: 1st July - 30th June for Stepping Stones. 1st January-31st July for Debut Handicap Championship. Numbers to qualify: Those pony/rider combinations who achieve four double clears (subject to revision) will qualify for the Final. Those ponies who achieve two double clears will also qualify for the Debut Handicap Championship Final at the Scope Festival (those qualified to Scope, are asked to email office@southviewarena.com). No rider may compete more than three ponies in the same section.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £18.00, Total: £93.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Dismounted prize giving – mandatory, in accordance with rule 101.7, (top 3 required)

Class 3 - Stainsby Grange Arena - Springboard 128/138cm Handicap

Rule 415. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 90cm / 1.00m. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with Rule 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all but for qualification purposes:

- In the 128cms section, Junior riders are eligible to enter, irrespective of points achieved, before the calendar year in which the age of 10 years is reached. Riders who reach the age of 10 years and over in the current calendar year must not have won a total of 500 points. (as of 01.08.2017 pony/rider combination).
- In the 138cms section, Junior riders are eligible to enter, irrespective of points achieved, before the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached. Riders who reach the age 12 years and over in the current calendar year must not have won a total of 850 points. (as of 01.08.2017 pony/rider combination). Junior Riders are not eligible to enter the 138cms section until the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached. Ponies 128cm & under are not permitted to enter the 138cm section.

Once riders have competed at, or have 'ever' qualified for RIHS or HOYS on any height pony they are no longer eligible to compete in the Final.

Pony/rider combinations who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the final of this competition.

Qualifies for: Springboard Final.

Qualifying Period: 1st February -31st January.

Numbers to Qualify: Four double clears to qualify for the Final. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification. In order to compete in the Final, all qualified competitors ages must be in accordance with the Rule 77.12 & 77.13 in the year of the Final.

No rider may compete more than three ponies in the same section.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £18.00, Total: £93.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Dismounted prize giving – mandatory, in accordance with rule 101.7, (top 3 required)

Class 4 - Stainsby Grange Arena - Graham Heath Equestrian (128/138cm) Championship Handicap Qualifier

Rule 284. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.00m / 1.10m. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Eligible Pony/rider: - Open to registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members ages in accordance with Rules 77.12&77.13. Pony/Riders are not eligible to compete in this class before the calendar year of which their eighth birthday is reached. Ponies may only compete in one section & no rider may ride more than three ponies in the same section.

Table: Single phase or Two Phase

Height of fences: - 128cms - 1.00m 138cms -1.10m

Numbers to qualify: Pony to record one double clear

Double clears recorded for the Winter/Summer 128/138cms(Subject to eligibility)

Class 5 - Stainsby Grange Arena - **Pony British Novice - First Round /80cm Open**

Rule 410. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm. **DRAWN ORDER**

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- British Novice:

For registered ponies in Grade JD, that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

- 80cm Open:

For registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members

If combined with an open:

In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £18.00, Total: £93.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Dismounted prize giving – mandatory, in accordance with rule 101.7, (top 3 required)

Class 6a - Stainsby Grange Arena - **90cm Novice Masters Championship Qualifier**

Rule 408. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm. **DRAWN ORDER**

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Eligible Pony/rider: - Open to registered ponies that have not won a total of 300 Points, to be ridden by Junior Members. Rider's ages in accordance with Rule 77.12 and 77.13.

Table: Single phase or Two phase

Height of fences: - 90cms

Numbers to qualify: - Pony to record one double clear.

Double clears recorded for the Pony Discovery (subject to Rule 408 eligibility criteria)

Class 6b - Stainsby Grange Arena - **Pony Intro 90cm Open**

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm. **DRAWN ORDER**

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £92.00. **Entry Fee = £17.00**

Dismounted prize giving – mandatory, in accordance with rule 101.7, (top 3 required)

Class 7 - Stainsby Grange Arena - Blue Chip Pony Newcomers/Pony 1.00m Open (both to inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Qualifier)

Rule 406 & 416. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m. **DRAWN ORDER**

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Blue Chip Pony Newcomers is for registered ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round.

- The Open Section is for registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. Junior Members, in either the Open or the Newcomers Section who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is ony/rider Combination.

Ponies may compete in one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £92.00. **Entry Fee = £17.00**

Class 8 - Stainsby Grange Arena - Pony Foxhunter - First Round/1.10m Open (both to Inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Qualifier)

Rule 404 & 417. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round.

- The Open Section is for registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. Junior Members, in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £92.00. **Entry Fee = £17.00**

Dismounted prize giving – mandatory, in accordance with rule 101.7, (top 3 required)

Class 9 - Stainsby Grange Arena - Junior 1.20m Open (inc. the 148cm Restricted Open Championship Qualifier)

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.20m. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by Junior Members.

This class is also a qualifier for the 148cm Restricted Open Championship. Rule 399, riders who have ever been on a Pony European Championship team, Pony Nation Cups team or pony/rider combinations in the top 10 of the Gold league as of 31st March 2022 are not eligible to qualify for the Final. The will be at the Welsh Home Pony Show. Qualifying period: 1 July 2021 - 30th June 2022 for the 2022 Final. Numbers to qualify: Those combinations who jump double clear (clear in the first round and the first jump-off) (one double clear) in the qualifying period. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round)).

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £40.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £160.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Dismounted prize giving – mandatory, in accordance with rule 101.7, (top 3 required)
