Class 1	Starter Stakes - for beginners – All clear rounds qualify for Aintree Under 45cms, X poles only, leadrein welcome. Jump off will not increase in height. No Fillers,
Class 2	Mini Minor 45cms, X poles and straight bars, no spreads, fillers at the side of jumps Leadrein welcome. Jump off will not increase in height.
Class 3	Mini 50cms, includes some fillers and straight bars, no spreads lead rein welcome (but won't qualify). Top 6 Junior riders qualify for Aintree
Class 4	Pre novice 60cms, will include fillers and spreads, No lead rein Top 6 Junior and top 6 senior riders qualify for Aintree
Class 5	Novice 70cms, includes fillers and spreads Top 6 Junior and top 6 senior riders qualify for Aintree
Class 6	Intermediate 80cms, includes fillers and spreads Top 6 Junior and top 6 senior riders qualify for Aintree
Class 7	Small Open 90cms, Includes fillers and spreads Top 6 Junior and top 6 senior riders qualify for Aintree
Class 8	Open 1m. Includes fillers and spreads, Top 6 seniors qualify for Aintree

Placings to 6th in all classes, Separate section for Seniors and Juniors in class 4-8 - Class one will have two sections of prizes and rosettes to all.

Class 1 Qualifying Rules for Aintree Please read the below before entering the class: All double clears will qualify for Aintree Any competitors competing in 50cm classes or above will not be eligible to compete in this class at the Unaffiliated Showjumping Championships at Aintree

For Classes 2 – 8 Qualifying Rules for Aintree Top 6 Senior and top 6 Junior combinations will qualify to the Championships, regardless of faults. If anyone from the top 6 cannot attend the Championships, the next placings will be invited to compete.

For qualifications purposes -

Juniors - Riders under 16 on a pony 14.2hh or under

Seniors - Riders of any age if the horse is 14.3hh & above
