BSPS TO COMPETE AT THIS SHOW**

Body Protectors **MUST** be worn when jumping in any WHP classes and, also when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organised and affiliated events.
All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.

HATS

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats as per rule 43 in the 2025 BSPS rulebook **MUST** be worn by riders at all times when mounted.

Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green.

Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme.

(We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags)

New for 2025 3A Memembers : Your judges will be talent spotting for the Showmans award which is held at the BSPS SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW. Cards will be given out to 3A members at our February, March and May shows.

Eligible classes:-

Show Pony 128cm,138cm,148cm, small & large intermediate SRT

Show Hunters 123cm,133cm,143cm,153cm, Intermediate SH

Plaited Cradle & Nursery ,133cm,143cm,153cm & Intermediate Plaited Working Hunter.

Open Heritage Small & Large Breeds

Heritage 122cm,133cm,143cm & exceeding 143cm Working Hunter Classes.

We will hold a final at the May show for competitors who have been awarded a card at any of the 3 shows. The winning rider will then be put forward to compete at the championship show in August.

Also New for 2025 The Young Pony Classes.

- Class 1 **Tiny Tots Lead Rein Stakes-** Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Ponies must be a Suitable size for rider. Rider to have attained their 3rd birthday but not to have attained their 8th birthday before January 1st in the current year. Maximum height and spread of fences 30cms. Open to plaited and unplaited ponies. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
- Class 2 **Tiny Tots Starter Stakes** - Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Ponies must be a Suitable size for rider. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before January 1st in the current year. Maximum height and spread of fences 35cms. Open to plaited and unplaited ponies.
- Class 3 **Cradle Stakes** - Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Ponies not exceeding 123cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before January 1st in the current year. Maximum height and spread of fences 45cms. Open to plaited and unplaited ponies.

WINTER WORKER STAKES (For plaited and Heritage animals)

Judge – David Dixon

- Class 4 **60cm Winter Worker Stakes** - Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland Ponies 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed junior under 12yrs of age on 1st January 2025 in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships
- Class 5 **70cm Winter Worker Stakes** - Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland ponies, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed junior under 14yrs of age on 1st January 2025 in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships.
- Class 6 **80cm Winter Worker Stakes** - Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland ponies, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed junior under 18yrs of age on 1st January 2025 in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships.
- Class 7 **90cm Winter Worker Stakes** - Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland ponies, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed junior

under 18yrs of age on 1st January 2025 in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships.

Class 8 **100cm Winter Worker Stakes** - Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland ponies, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed junior under 25yrs of age on 1st January 2025 in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships.

N.B. Ponies may compete in more than one height section. Rider should be appropriate age on the day of the Show. The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider

Class 9 BSPS Heritage Mountain and Moorland Novice Lead Rein. Registered pure bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A or B not exceeding 122cms, four years old and over. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before January 1st in the current year.

Class 10 BSPS Heritage Mountain and Moorland Novice First Ridden. Registered pure bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A or B not exceeding 128cms, four years old and over. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before January 1st in the current year.

Class 11 BSPS Heritage Mountain and Moorland Challenge/Open Lead Rein Registered pure bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A or B not exceeding 122cms, four years old and over. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before January 1st in the current year.

Class 12 BSPS Heritage Mountain and Moorland Challenge/Open First Ridden Registered pure-bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A or B not exceeding 128cms, four

years old and over. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before January 1st in the current year.

Mini Championship – 1st and 2nd placed competitors from classes 9-12

Class 13 THE YOUNG HERITAGE PONY OF THE YEAR

Registered Heritage Stallion, Mare or Gelding. 4, 5 or 6 yrs. old. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride.

Class 14 BSPS Heritage Novice Mountain and Moorland Ridden Small Breeds Registered pure bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A or B, four years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 15 BSPS Heritage Novice Mountain and Moorland Ridden Large Breeds Registered New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Fell, Dales, Welsh C or D, four years old and over. Riders any age.

Novice Championship - 1st and 2nd placed competitors from classes 14 & 15

Class 16 BSPS Heritage Mountain and Moorland Challenge/Open mixed Breeds Registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C & D, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Fell or Dales four years old and over. Riders any age.

Rules & Regulation

In the Young Pony classes ponies can be shown in any suitable bridle.

The highest placed 4, 5 and 6 year old pony in each class will qualify for the final the BSPS Winter Championship Show.

The Winter Worker Stakes and the Young Pony classes are qualifiers for the Winter Championship Show, no other BSPS classes require qualification.

Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.

It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes if there are insufficient entries.

This show is affiliated to the BSPS (All rules as per the 2025 Rule & Show Handbook) and all persons competing or otherwise taking part are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Winter Championships 2025
