The Venue is located next door to Sowerby Caravan Park (the same side of the road)
The Post code will take you further down the road. There are Grey electric gates and a
white Show Sign. Parking is on grass if firm or hard standing.

If you are coming down the A19 exit at Thirsk keep on the A19 heading towards York until
you get to the Dalton/Sowerby junction on your right.

Do not turn off the A19 any sooner as you will get to a narrow bridge.

- All Riders to wear Correctly fitted headgear PAS015 or Higher whilst mounted anywhere on the show ground.
- Handlers under 18 are required to wear a riding hat with safety harness fastened at all times.
- Anyone riding on the premises must wear correct footwear.
- Anyone riding on the property do so at their own risk. The owners of the property are not responsible for any accident or injury.
- Spurs are permitted for over 18 years Old riders only.
- Children under 18 Must be supervised at all times
