Held at The Ings Sowerby Thirsk YO7 3AG

The Venue is located next door to Sowerby Caravan Park (the same side of the road) The Post code will take you further down the road.

There are Grey electric gates and a white Show Sign
Parking is on grass if firm or hard standing.

If you are coming down the A19 exit at Thirsk keep on the A19 heading towards York until you get to the Dalton/Sowerby junction on your right.

Do not turn off the A19 any sooner as you will get to a narrow bridge.

Rules

Once the entries close there are Strictly No refunds (Unless the event is cancelled then entry fees will be returned) **Entry fees are strictly non refundable and not transferable**

You do not have to be an NPS Member to compete at this show.

Competitors enter Edenthorpe Equestrian premises at their own risk. The owner takes no responsibility for any loss or damage to persons, horses, vehicles or property whilst on the property.

No Horse or Pony Under the age of 4 years of ages may be ridden on the show ground. Competitors must be a minimum age of 3 years of age on the date of the show.

Competitors in LR/FR Must use a snaffle Bridle and Lead rein attached to the nose band only

Any Stallions must be ridden/Handled by a competent person minimum age of 18

All Riders to wear Correctly fitted headgear PAS015 or Higher whilst mounted anywhere on the show ground.

Handlers under 16 are required to wear a riding hat with safety harness fastened at all times.

Anyone riding on the premises must wear correct footwear.

Anyone riding on the property do so at their own risk. The owners of the property are not responsible for any accident or injury.

Spurs are not permitted

Children under 16 Must be supervised at all times

RULES

- 1 The Judge's decision is final.
- 2 The organisers of the show accept no responsibility whatsoever for loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the Showground.
- 3 NO nomination or substitute entries will be accepted.
- 4 NO entry fee will be refunded. In the event of cancellation of the event a percentage may be refunded, but the remainder will be retained to cover administration.
- 5 The organisers of the show reserve the right to amend the schedule and to refuse entries at their discretion.
- 6 Objections to be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the event, with a deposit of £50, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred's are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **5th to 7th August 2025**.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring.

NPS/WTJ Insurance Brokers Ltd Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home-Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

The Champion & Reserve Champion from the Riding Pony Breeding, Hunter Pony Breeding and Mountain & Moorland Inhand Classes will qualify for The Final to be held at the NPS Area 4 Show on Monday August 27th, 2025. Qualifiers do not need to be members of the NPS

Working Hunter Pony Classes -

Judged in Ring 1 - All Weather Arena Start 8 am

No rider may ride more than one pony in a class except that riders in all WHP and Arena Eventing classes that are not qualifiers for HOYS or RIHS may ride up to two ponies of the same height in a class, and both ponies can go forward for show and conformation judging. There must be no change of rider between the phases

The NPS/STEVENSON BROTHERS ROCKING HORSES M&M First Ridden Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-FRWHP)

Open to registered M&M mares or geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm. Riders must have attained their 5th birthday but must not have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Riders who have qualified for the (Horse of the Year Show/RIHS) M&M Working Hunter Pony Championship before the 1st January in the current year are not eligible.

Ponies must not be asked to gallop.

The three highest placed ponies, owned by an NPS member, in each class go forward to the final. Where these ponies have already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than fifth place.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

Won an open affiliated WHP class

Qualified for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS Open WHP classes

iii)

show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).

Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship

iv) If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de- noviced and cannot compete in the Novice WHP Final.

v) Ponies that have won more than 5 BE points or 200 BS points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January in the current year, are not eligible to compete in novice working classes.

Pony never to have won a first prize **of £5 or more** in First Ridden classes or qualified for the NPS Partridge and Parr M&M First Ridden Final before 1st January in current year.
