Held at The Ings Sowerby Thirsk YO7 3AG

The Venue is located next door to Sowerby Caravan Park (the same side of the road) The Post code will take you further down the road.

There are Grey electric gates and a white Show Sign
Parking is on grass if firm or hard standing.

If you are coming down the A19 exit at Thirsk keep on the A19 heading towards York until you get to the Dalton/Sowerby junction on your right.

Do not turn off the A19 any sooner as you will get to a narrow bridge.

Rules

REFUNDS AND TRANSFERS OF ENTRIES

Once entered we do not offer refunds.

If you wish to withdraw up to 48 hours before the competition we can transfer your entries to a similar event held within one month.

After this month if the entries aren't taken up they are forfeited

Less than 48 hours before including on the day - absolutely no refunds or transfers of classes.

ENTRIES / CLOSING TIMES / ENTRY LISTS

Please note new entry closing times two days before each competition at 9pm

Late entries accepted up until 4pm the day before

Please note we do NOT accept entries on the day if you have not pre entered.

Competitors may enter extra classes on the day for a £2 late fee if they have already pre entered via horse events Entries on the day are card or cash

ONCE THE ENTRIES HAVE CLOSED the full entry list and not before times for each section will be published

Please do not message asking for entry numbers or times before then.

Competitors enter Edenthorpe Equestrian premises at their own risk. The owner takes no responsibility for any loss or damage to persons, horses, vehicles or property whilst on the property.

No Horse or Pony Under the age of 4 years of ages may be ridden on the show ground. Competitors must be a minimum age of 3 years of age.

Competitors in LR/FR Must use a snaffle Bridle and Lead rein attached to the nose band only

Any Stallions must be ridden/Handled by a competent person minimum age of 14

All Riders to wear Correctly fitted headgear PAS015 or Higher whilst mounted anywhere on the show ground.

Handlers under 16 are required to wear a riding hat with safety harness fastened at all times.

Anyone riding on the premises must wear correct footwear.

Anyone riding on the property do so at their own risk. The owners of the property are not responsible for any accident or injury.

Spurs are permitted for over 16 years Old riders only.

Children under 16 Must be supervised at all times

- Please PICK UP any poo you create There are many skips available to use.
- DO NOT MUCK OUT TRAILERS & HORSEBOXES PLEASE
- Please keep dogs on leads at all times

- Strictly no lunging.

- **Classes must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies.**
- **Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.**
- **Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show.**
- **To enter a stallion in ANY class (in-hand or performance) at an affiliated show, entire males aged 4 years old and over must have an "S" number and have been successfully through either the SPS-BS Stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPS-BS Voluntary Veterinary Examination.**
- **Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge.**
- **In hand colts/stallions of two years old or over must be shown bitted and are advised to display a colt or stallion bridle badge, these are available to purchase from the SPS-BS.**
- **There must be no colts or stallions in Young Handlers classes. Young Handlers must be a minimum of 3 years of age on the day of the show.**
- **Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or Stallions in In-hand classes.**
- **Children aged under 12 years old on the day of their class may not show a stallion in ridden classes.**
- **In the interests of safety, hard hats conforming to current British Safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-hand classes.**
- **For Health & Safety purposes judges and exhibitors must remain standing whilst in the ring when showing ponies. KNEELING IS NOT PERMITTED.**

- Hard hats conforming to current British Safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes.
- Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old or over. In ridden Classes
- if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.
