There are Grey electric gates and a white Show Sign Parking is on grass if firm or hard standing.

If you are coming down the A19 exit at Thirsk keep on the A19 heading towards York until you get to the Dalton/Sowerby junction on your right.

Do not turn off the A19 any sooner as you will get to a narrow bridge.

Spurs are permitted for over 16 years Old riders only.

Children under 16 Must be supervised at all times
