Riding Cub Horse Test HCTG-RC1 (2025)

- 1** **A** Enter at working Trot
- 2** **X** Turn left to H
- 3** **C** Serpentine 3 loops finishing at A
- Between
- 4** **A&K** Transition to Canter
- 5** **E** Circle right 20 meters diameter
- Between
- 6** **H&C** Transition to Trot
- 7** **MXK** Change rein
- Between
- 8** **A&F** Transition to Canter
- 9** **B** Circle 20 Meters diameter
- Between
- 10** **M&C** Transition to trot
- Between
- 11** **C&H** Transition to walk
- 12** **E—B** Half Circle 20 meters diameter free walk on a long rein
- 13** **B** Commence quarter circle medium walk
- Between
- 14** **G&X** Halt and Salute (across the centre line)

Leave arena the arena and ride directly to the jumping phase, commence jumping on the judges signal. On completion of the fences, show some forward canter strides, before walking and halting for the judge. Confirmation will be judged during your final halt.

Collective marks will be given for the following.

Dressage: rideability, harmony and balance.

Jumping: technique and control.
