#### **MAIN RING HORSE SHOW**

MAIN RING – 9.00am JUDGE – TBC

Class 1. RACEHORSE TO RIDING HORSE mare or gelding Thoroughbred 4yrs old and over exceeding 15hh (153cm) that has been in training and is registered at Weatherby's, to be judged on suitability to be retrained, individual show, blemishes will not be considered.

**Class 2**. **OPEN RIDDEN HUNTER** 4yrs and over, exceeding 153cm. Rider any age. Judge will not ride, class will be marked on confirmation and individual show.

**Class 3. FANCY DRESS ON HORSEBACK** This class will be in the main ring at approximately 3pm and the entry is free. Rosettes and prize money awarded.

**Class 6. BEST COMBINATION IN FIRST SEASON OF SHOWING** The Claire Robinson Memorial Trophy has been kindly donated in memory of Claire Robinson.

- **Class 7. FAMILY PONY** to be judged on suitability for every member of the family to ride and handle. No lead reins permitted. Conformation will not be considered.
- Class 8. LEAD REIN PONY/TINY TOTS PONY any height, rider 9yrs and under, rosette to best Tiny Tots pony which will be judged on suitability as a small child's pony. Rider to be 5yrs and under. This class will be judged on suitability of the pony, conformation will not be considered. The Robinsons Equi Teach Trophies have been kindly donated in memory of Claire Robinson. This class will be split if enough entries under 5's and 5-9 years.
- Class 9. BONNY PONY in hand or ridden.
- Class 10. THELWELL LOOK ALIKE lead rein permitted, riders 10 and under.
- Class 11. IN HAND YOUNG HANDLER 16yrs and under to be judged on how the child presents the pony.
- Class 12. IN HAND YOUNG PONY 3yrs and under any type.
- Class 13. RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE OR PONY 15yrs and over, small show required.

**Class 14. MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS RIDDEN** Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or Gelding, 4 yrs old and over, not exceeding 122cms. *Lead Reins permitted and will be split if enough entries*.

**Class 15. OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN** Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies, Welsh section C, D, Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland and New Forest.
