#### LIGHT HORSES

#### **RULES OF THE SHOW**

- Prize money may be withdrawn/or reduced depending on the amount of catalogued entries in a class. Ridden prize money: If 6 or less exhibits catalogued prize money will only be awarded to 2nd place. For all in hand classes prize money will be awarded as follows:- three entries or less 1st prize only, four or five entries 1st and 2nd prize and 6 or more entries 1st 2nd and 3rd prize only
- 2. If deemed necessary, the organizers may use alternative judges to the ones stated in this schedule
- Competitors should be aware of the wording of the societies rules that they compete under, the Show Committee will not be held responsible for any misunderstanding regarding these rules
- 4. Entry fees will only be refunded with a valid vet or medical certificate produced BEFORE show day, minus a 10% admin fee.
- 5. The Show Society reserves the right to measure any animal at any time
- 6. Closing dates for entries is 28th August 2022. Some late entries maybe accepted at the Light Horse Secretaries discretion
- 7. Failure to return trophies will result in the exhibitor concerned being refused entry to this and any future shows that are run by North Yorkshire County Agricultural Show.
- 8. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
- 9. Any judge change after this schedule has been printed will be notified on our website.
- 10. All exhibitors must have adequate public liability insurance
- 11. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check if the show is still taking place due to bad weather.
- 12. All prize money, prizes and cups to be collected on the show day, nothing to be sent out after the show day
- 13. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes
- 14. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for accidents or damage to riders, competitors, spectators, owners or animals or any other property.
- 15. The decision of the judge is final

- 19. Under no circumstances is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal.

#### NORTHERN COUNTIES PONY ASSOCIATION

This show is a qualifier for the N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show. First and Second prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify. This show is a qualifier for the NCPA GOLDEN SUPREMES held in September 2019. Supreme Champion & Reserve prize winners will qualify from the supreme in hand and supreme ridden.

#### THE NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show Date and Location TBC

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

#### NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championship

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

#### **EQUIFEST QUALIFIERS**

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on the Date and Time TBC

#### IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY

The following classes are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership are eligible for entry. All Pure Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register OR registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. The owners of all Pure Bred Irish Draught horses must be full members of the IDHS (GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sport Horses. Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the Show to confirm eligibility. All Yearling, Two

and Three year old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All Three year old colts must be un-inspected.

THE IDHS (GB) £2000 RIDDEN CHALLENGE Details and wording for Ridden Hunters. Cobs and Riding Horse classes affiliated to the SHB (GB) and the BSHA. All Ridden Hunter, Cob and Riding Horse classes at shows affiliated to Sport Horse Breeding (GB) and British Show Horse Association (BSHA) can be qualifiers for the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge. Qualifiers may be taken from the highest placed horses (with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding) competing in ridden small, lightweight, middleweight, or heavyweight classes, also ladies hunter, novice hunter, amateur hunter, working hunter and novice working hunter classes at shows affiliated to the Sport Horse Breeding (GB), and in ridden cob, working cob, maxi cob and riding horse classes at shows affiliated to the British Show Horse AssociationThis show is a qualifier for the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from each of the following classes, that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding, will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge. Horses need not be registered with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) to qualify but must be on the IDHS (GB) Registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show 2023(Date and Venue to be confirmed. In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money and a trophy. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500, and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition the highest placed Purebred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, and the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50. A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a card. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhsqb.org.uk to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the final.

This show is a Qualifier for The Moorbennhall Irish Draught Youngstock Challenge. The two highest placed pure-breds from each age group that have not already qualified in Class/Classes - yearlings, two year olds and three year olds - eligible for Class 1 in the Irish Draught Breed Register by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) sire, out of a graded dam, or if one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group will qualify to go forward to their respective final, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show 2023, Date and Venue to be confirmed. Each qualifier will receive a card. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhsgb.org.uk to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the final. In the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship where the Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150.

B.S.P.S. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. This Show is a qualifier for the 2023 B.S.P.S. Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in open classes in the following sections Show Ponies, Mini Show Ponies, Show Hunter, Working Hunter Ponies and Mini WHP and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prize-winners in the Open Intermediate S.R.T.(including Mixed height) W.H. and S.H.T. and C.S. and in MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES the 1st. 2nd. 3rd. and 4th placed ponies will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a B.S.P.S. member. 1st and 2nd places in the nursery stakes class will qualify for the BSPS Summer Championship Show. This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Blue Riband Pony of the Year, the 1st and 2nd prize winners in the Lead Rein, First Ridden OR Open Show Pony OR Open Working Hunter Pony OR Open Show Hunter Pony

OR Open Intermediate WH SRT and SH Classes will qualify. This Show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Classic Services Group Challenge - see Rule 516. Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes. THE B.S.P.S. BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS - This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S.
