- 1. Prize money may be withdrawn/or reduced depending on the amount of catalogued entries in a class. Ridden prize money: If 6 or less exhibits catalogued prize money will only be awarded to 2nd place. For all in hand classes prize money will be awarded as follows:- three entries or less 1st prize only, four or five entries 1st and 2nd prize and 6 or more entries 1st 2nd and 3rd prize only
- 2. If deemed necessary, the organizers may use alternative judges to the ones stated in this schedule
- 3. Competitors should be aware of the wording of the societies rules that they compete under, the Show Committee will not be held responsible for any misunderstanding regarding these rules
- 4. Entry fees will only be refunded with a valid vet or medical certificate produced BEFORE show day, minus a 10% admin fee.
- 5. The Show Society reserves the right to measure any animal at any time
- 6. Closing dates for entries is 28th August 2022. Some late entries maybe accepted at the Light Horse Secretaries discretion
- 7. Failure to return trophies will result in the exhibitor concerned being refused entry to this and any future shows that are run by North Yorkshire County Agricultural Show.
- 8. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
- 9. Any judge change after this schedule has been printed will be notified on our website.
- 10. All exhibitors must have adequate public liability insurance
