Working Hunter Ring

STARTING at 9.30am

Class 1) STARS Lead rein Working Hunter Pony, not to exceed 128cm, rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st Jan 2024. Max jump height 30cm

Class 2) STARS Tiny Tot Working Hunter Pony, not exceed 128cm, rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st Jan 2024. Max jump height 40cm

Class 3) 40cm Unaffiliated Working Hunter – Open to any horse or pony.

Class 4) STARS Mountain and Moorland & Plaited Working Hunter Pony 133cm and under, rider any age but must be suitable for the size of the pony. Max jump height 60cm (To be judged separately. One Plaited and One M&M will qualify for STARS final)

Class 5) 60cm Unaffiliated Working Hunter – Open to any horse or pony.

Class 6) STARS Mountain and Moorland & Plaited Working Hunter Pony over 133cm, rider any age but must be suitable for the size of the pony. Max jump height 70cm (To be judged separately. One Plaited and One M&M will qualify for STARS final)

Class 7) 70cm Unaffiliated Working Hunter – Open to any horse or pony.

Class 8) 80cm Unaffiliated Working Hunter - Open to any horse or pony.

Class 9) STARS Working Hunter Horse exceeding 153cm, must be plaited or hogged, rider any age. Max jump height 90cm

Class 10) 90cm Unaffiliated Working Hunter – Open to any horse or pony.

Class 11) STARS Riding Club Pony – Open to riders any age, pony not to exceed 148cm. Will include a jump max height 60cm.

Class 12) STARS Riding Club Horse - Open to riders any age, horse must exceed 148cm. Will include a jump max height 80cm

Working Hunter CHAMPIONSHIP – Those who have come 1^{st} or 2^{nd} in classes 1-12 are eligible for this championship.

In Hand Classes



Inhand Ring

All classes open to Non-Members

STARTING AT 9:30am

Class 13) STARS Youngstock – Open to any type of exhibit yearlings, 2- or 3-year-olds.

Class 14) STARS In Hand Plaited Pony – Open to all plaited ponies not exceeding 148cm. To be shown plaited and trimmed.

Class 15) STARS In Hand Plaited Horse - Open to all plaited horses exceeding 148cm. To be shown plaited and trimmed.

Class 16) STARS In hand M & M small breeds – Open to M & M small breed types, Shetlands, Welsh A & B, Dartmoor, and Exmoor.

Class 17) STARS In hand M & M Large Breed - Open to M & M large breed types, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Welsh C & D.

Class 18) STARS In Hand Cob – Open to ALL cobs including traditional.

Class 19) ROR Inhand.

Class 20) STARS In hand veteran – Open to all horses and ponies 14 years and over.

Class 21) Inhand Hunter / Sports Horse

Class 22) Inhand Rescue

Class 23) STARS In hand coloured Horse/Pony – Open to all coloured ponies not exceeding 143cm. (Will be judged separately)

Class 24) STARS Young Handler – Handlers to have attained their 8th birthday but not their 12th birthday before 1st January 2024. Horse or pony any height.

Class 25) STARS Tiny Tot Handler – Handlers to have attained their 4th birthday but not their 8th birthday before 1st January 2024. Pony not to exceed 128cm. Handlers must be accompanied by an adult in the ring, BUT the adult may not assist in the handling of the pony unless the handler is in difficulty. Ponies must be suitable for the child.

Class 25a) STARS Junior Handler – Handlers to have attained their 12th birthday but not their 18th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Horses or ponies any height.

Class 26) Open Inhand – Open to any horse or pony.

INHAND CHAMPIONSHIP – Those who have come 1st or 2nd in classes 13 – 26 are eligible for this championship.



Ridden Flat Classes



Ridden Ring

All classes open to Non-Members

Starting time 10:00am

Class 27) Novice Horse and Pony. Snaffle bridle only. (Walk and Trot in go round only, option to canter in individual show)

Class 28) Novice Rider (Walk and Trot in go round only, option to canter in individual show)

Class 29) STARS Lead rein plaited & M&M (To be judged separately) - Riders NOT to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January 2024. Ponies must not exceed 128cm. Snaffle bridles only.

Class 29a) STARS First Ridden – Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 128cm. Snaffle bridles only.

Class 30) STARS Open Hunter Pony / Show Pony (To be judged separately)

Class 31) STARS Open Hunter Horse / Show Horse (To be judged separately)

Class 32) STARS Racehorse to Riding horse – Open to all Ex Racehorses that have raced under rules. Any suitable bridle.

Class 33) STARS Ridden Show Cob – Open to ALL ridden cobs including traditional, rider any age.

Class 34) STARS Ridden Plaited Coloured – Open to all plaited coloured horses and ponies. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle.

Class 35) STARS Ridden Native, Traditional, Coloured Cob - Open to all native, cob, traditional type, coloured horses and ponies. Any suitable bridle. Rider any age.

Class 36) STARS Ridden veteran – Open to all horses and ponies aged 14 - 19 years. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle.

Class 37) STARS Ridden veteran – Open to all horses and ponies aged 20 years+. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle.

Class 38) STARS Ridden M & M large breeds – Open to Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Welsh C & D. Rider any age.

Class 39) STARS Ridden M & M small breeds – Open to Shetlands, Welsh A & B, Dartmoor and Exmoor. Rider any age but must be suitable for height of exhibit.

Class 40) STARS Equitation (Junior Under 18 years & Senior Over 18 years, Lead Reins Under 10 years old to be judged separately). Snaffle bridles only. Lead Reins to be pulled in and do individual show, Lead rein to be attached to noseband. Horses and ponies any height.

Class 41) Open Ridden – Open to any horse or pony.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP – Those who have come 1st or 2nd in classes 27 – 41 are eligible for this championship.



CHAPS Classes



This Show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 25-095 Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid qualifier card. Members to apply in to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 14th - 16th August 2025.

For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com. Only "coloured" horses and ponies (as defined in the current CHAPS UK Members' Handbook) may compete in these classes.

All stallions, 4 yrs old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID discs in the ring without exception.

Class 43: CHAPS (UK) Native/Cob/Traditional Open In-Hand Qualifier, any height. Any age, no foals.

Class 44: CHAPS (UK) Non-Native Open In-Hand Qualifier, any height. Any age, no foals.

Class 45: CHAPS (UK) Native/Cob/Traditional Open Ridden Qualifier, any height.

Class 46: CHAPS (UK) Non-Native Open Ridden Qualifier, any height.
