Clear Round: 08:00, Classes begin at 09:00 (times per class to be issued 2 days prior to competition)

<mark>Class 1</mark>. Lead Rein Class Jumps max 30cm no fillers, no spreads

Class 2. 40cm Class Jumps max 40cm high, no fillers, no spreads

Class 3. 50cm Class Jumps max 50cm high narrow spreads only

Class 4. 60cm Class Jumps will not exceed 60cm high, only a few fillers

Class 5. 70cm Class Jumps will not exceed 70cm high

Not before 13:00

Class 6. 80cm Class Jumps will not exceed 80cm high

Class 7. 90cm Class Jumps will not exceed 90cm high

Class 8. 1m Class Jumps will not exceed 1m high

The first part of the course is over show jumps, going straight into the cross country phase which will be a mixture of worker jumps and portable cross country fences. There is a short timed section in the cross country phase that will be clearly marked out.

Dress code is cross country wear. A body protector is advised. Fancy dress encouraged with prizes to the best dressed!

Rosettes to 6th place, special prize to 1st place if 5-9 entries, then prizes for 1st and 2nd for 10-14 entries. Prizes 1st-3rd for 15+ entries.

Café open serving delicious festive takeaway food and drink. Please note that masks must be worn inside café area.

RULES AND USEFUL INFORMATION

- Social distancing and practising good hygiene whilst onsite is mandatory.
- Spectators are limited to one per competitor.
- All individuals (aside from those normally exempt in government rules) must wear a face covering in all areas except the area around your lorry/trailer or if mounted
- All spectators must maintain adequate distance from anyone not within their household/support bubble. Note that adults must ensure children adhere to this too
- Registration of attendee names and contact information will be requested at the point of entering the competition.

- Times for each class will be issued in advance of the competition.
- We kindly ask that competitors depart site promptly upon completion of their classes
- Any objection must be made to the secretary accompanied by a £10 deposit.
- All cash prizes to be collected from secretary's office after the section has concluded.
- All classes listed are open to all persons. We may split classes if entries suffice.
- No refund will be given to anybody withdrawing from classes.
- No liability is accepted for any injury, accident, loss or damage to spectators, animals, vehicles or personal property.
- Usual riding centre rules apply.
- The Centre management reserve the right to cancel, modify or alter any class or classes as they deem necessary. In the event of cancellation due to Covid-19 restrictions, all entry fees, minus booking fee, will be refunded within 7 working days.
