### In Hand Classes

*Commence 09:00 in main indoor arena.  
Judge: TBC*

- 1) Shetland and miniatures
- 2) Young stock 3 years and under (note that colts 2 year and over must be suitably bitted and lead by competent handler)
- 3) Best rescue / rehabilitated pony / horse
- 4) Hunter / sports horse
- 5) Mountain and Moorland pure breeds (class may be split if there are suitable entries)
- 6) Retrained racehorse (must have ran under rules)
- 7) Veteran horse / pony
- 8) Coloured horse / pony
- 9) Best young handler 12 years and under

### Ridden Classes

*Commencing not before 12:30 in main indoor arena. Judge: TBC*

- 10) Best tack and turnout
- 11) Best rider 8 years and under on a lead rein
- 12) Best rider 16 years and under (no lead reins)
- 13) Best combination 8 years and under on lead rein
- 14) First ridden pony 9 years and under off the lead rein
- 15) Best pony 14.2hh and under (rider to be 16 years and under)
- 16) Best Horse 14.3hh and over
- 17) Best combination open (no lead reins)
- 18) Best ridden Mountain and Moorland
- 19) Best ridden Hunter exceeding 15hh
- 20) Best ridden retrained racehorse (must have ran under rules)
- 21) Best veteran ridden horse or pony 16 years and over
- 22) Best coloured ridden horse or pony



## RULES AND USEFUL INFORMATION

- *Social distancing and practising good hygiene whilst onsite is mandatory.*
- *Spectators are limited to one per competitor.*
- *All individuals (aside from those normally exempt in government rules) must wear a face covering in all areas except the area around your lorry/trailer or if mounted.*
- *All spectators must maintain adequate distance from anyone not within their household/support bubble. Note that adults must ensure children adhere to this too.*
- *Registration of attendee names and contact information will be requested at the point of entering the competition.*
- *The NHS Contact Tracing app QR code will be onsite for all attendees over the age of 16 to scan.*
- *Entries in advance for all classes via our website.*
- *Times for each class will be issued in advance of the competition.*
- *We kindly ask that competitors depart site promptly upon completion of their classes.*
- *Any objection must be made to the secretary accompanied by a £10 deposit.*
- *No refund will be given to anybody withdrawing from classes.*
- *No liability is accepted for any injury, accident, loss or damage to spectators, animals, vehicles or personal property.*
- *Usual riding centre rules apply.*
