Please note that we are trying to run classes for everyone, therefore we request competitors adhere to the following rules. This will help us to get through all the classes in a reasonable time.

1. All Classes will be jumped in a set order.
2. You must declare at the ringside at least 15 minutes before the start of your class.
3. Please state clearly on your entry form, what section you are competing in for a mixed height class.
4. The course will be available to walk for a short time **ONLY** prior to each class. Please be ready to walk, all those competing to walk the course together, we will not hold up the course walk if you are late!
5. Please enter the ring in TROT and proceed straight to the first fence, **DO NOT** halt by the judge. After jumping the last fence leave the arena in trot, **DO NOT** stop and salute. Proceed to collecting ring of show/conformation ring.
6. Please note that rosettes will be presented in the conformation ring.

BSHA WORKING SHOW HORSE

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Competitors and Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Riders must be 15 years old or over. Qualifiers for the SEIB Working Show Horse of the Year Championship, to be held at the BSHA National Championship Show. The two highest placed horses, in the top five, not already qualified in each Open Working Show Horse class, will qualify for the Championship; no horse placed lower than fifth will qualify. Any Horse which is a Grade B Showjumper, Intermediate Eventer, or above, as at the 1st January of the current year, is not eligible to compete in any Working Show Horse class. A Rider may ride up to two Horses in the jumping phase but must then select on Horse to take through to the Ride and Conformation phases (if required). No change of Rider is allowed. Horses may wear protective boots, of a plain colour, for the jumping phase only; no weighted boots are permitted, no change of tack is permitted between jumping and flat phases.

Open to mares, geldings and stallions four year old and over, in possession of an equine passport but no specific registration or breed society criteria. Plaited ponies to a maximum of 153cm. Riders may only ride one pony in each class

Height of fences 69cms to 84cms

Class 61: The NPS/Team Harvey Working Hunter Pony Training Stakes 99cm (Open to both Plaited & M&M)

Open to mares, geldings and stallions four year old and over, in possession of an equine passport but no specific registration or breed society criteria. Plaited ponies to a maximum of 153cm. Riders may only ride one pony in each class

Height of fences 84cms to 99cms.

Class 62: SWPA Open Mixed Type Lead Rein WHP (Inc. M&M). Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over not exceeding 122cms. M & M exhibits must be registered in their respected Pure Breed Society Stud Book. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a SNAFFLE BRIDLE. The Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband only and held in the Leader's outside hand. Affiliated to South West Ponies.

Class 63: The NPS M & M First Ridden Stevenson Brothers WHP

Mares and geldings four years old or over, not exceeding 128 cms, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Rider over 5 years but under 12 years (see rules in section A 3.2). - The Show is also affiliated to the British Show Horse Association and the relevant classes will be judged under their rules
- **This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Summer Championship Show 2019.** The 1st and 2nd prize winners in the Open Nursery and Open WHPs Open SHPs Open L/R F/R and Open Show Pony classes will qualify. The 1st 2nd and 3rd in the Open Intermediate classes.
- **This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Binks Family 50th Year Golden Anniversary Champion of Champions, the 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead rein, first Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate SH & SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes.**
- **This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS The White Company Mini WHP Champion of Champions. The 1st prize winner in the Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes will qualify.**
- **This show is a qualifier for the 2019 Royal International Horse Show.** The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first 3 will qualify in the following classes: Open LR, Open F/R, Open Nursery Stakes, Open 133cm 143cm and 153cm WHP, L/R of HT, Open 122cm 133cm, 143 cm & 153 cm SHP, Open Intermediate SRT small and large, Open & Pretty Polly Heritage Ridden, Intermediate SH & WH, Pretty Polly Heritage LR & Heritage 1st Ridden, Pretty Polly Mixed Height Show Pony, Pretty Polly Mixed Height SHP, Heritage LR and 1st Ridden & Heritage Open Ridden. In these classes ponies must be owned and ridden by a BSPS Member. Except for the and Part-bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS.
- **This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Classic Security (UK) Ltd** All summer qualifying shows that are affiliated to the B.S.P.S. are qualifiers for the "The B.S.P.S." **Classic Security (UK) Ltd** and schedules must state :-Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Show Pony, SHP, WHP Nursery Stakes, Int SRT, SH, WH and Heritage M&M Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Challenge. Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any B.S.P.S. affiliated Show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2019 Horse of The Year Show in the appropriate class.

- **The Blue Riband Pony of the Year competition:** 1st & 2nd placed prize winners in each of the Open WHP, SHP, Open Show Pony, L/R and 1st Ridden classes and 1st & 2nd prize winners in the Open Intermediate WH, SRT & SH classes will qualify. Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with Blue Riband qualification.
- **BSPS Premier League Competition:** This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League. Animals competing in the following classes will qualify. Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate, SH, SRT & WH, and Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP.
- **BSPS Black Country Saddles Rider of the Year Competition:** The best rider from each of the following classes will qualify, Open Show Pony, SHP, WHP Open L/R F/R L/R of HT, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes and Open Intermediate classes and Heritage classes see rule 521.
- **Neither the BSPS nor the committee, any Judge, Steward or any other Official shall be liable** for injury or damage to any person, animal, article or property. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor or competitor shall indemnify the organisers and hold them harmless against such matters aforesaid.
- Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. All PAS015,VG1, (BS)EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged.
- A rider whose hat comes off will be eliminated. A rider whose strap comes undone, whilst competing must on Penalty of Elimination replace it or fasten it before continuing. He may stop without penalty to fasten the strap.
- In the interest of Health & Safety the B.S.P.S. Council are determined that riders must comply with Rule 45. The B.S.P.S. will authorise spot checks at certain Shows and riders breaking this Rule will not be allowed to compete.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION ROYAL INTERNATIONAL QUALIFYING CLASSES

- **Classes 25 to 33 and class 57** are held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all owners, exhibitors and riders must be Association Members.
- Riders must be 15 years of age or older.
- Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.
- Classes 25 to 28 and 31 to 33 are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.
- Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse Classes.
- The three highest placed prizewinners in all **OPEN** affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show in September 2019
- The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each **OPEN** class and a Champion rosette for each section (except for Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).
- The Association will also award an Amateur Home Produced rosette in Affiliated Open Cob (Lightweight & Heavyweight only) classes. These rosettes have been **kindly sponsored by TSG, Mr. L Turley**. The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year.
- The highest placed Amateur Home Produced exhibit in all Royal International qualifying classes will need to contact Sarah Butler by e-mail sarah@bluechipfeed.com or on 0114 266 6200 (a maximum of one rosette to be won at a RIHS qualifier and one rosette at a HOYS qualifier per horse. The award will then pass down the line).

NPS/PICTON M & M Novice Ridden National Championship Classes to 44-48

- Stallions, mares and geldings, 4 years old or over, registered in the main body of Respective Breed Society Stud Book. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st of January in the current year, it has done any of the following:
 - Won an open Affiliated mixed M & M Ridden Class.
 - Qualified for HOYS, Olympia or RIHS Open M & M Ridden classes.
 - Qualified for the M & M Novice or Intermediate Ridden Final at the NPS Summer Championship Show (nb ponies can compete as Novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided, they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year)
 - If a pony qualifies for HOYS, Olympia or RIHS in its second year, it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.
- Rider any age, except Stallions (see Rules in Section A3.2).
- The Owner does not have to be an NPS Member for the pony to enter this competition, but only ponies owned by NPS qualifying or life members can qualify for the final.
- The highest placed pony, owned by an NPS member, in each class goes forward to the final. Where this pony has already qualified, the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS Member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than third place.
- Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.
- A Minimum of six ponies must be stripped in qualifying rounds. All ponies must be stripped in the NPS final.

NPS/STANDING HAT STUD & SHOW TEAM M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette

- a) This Championship is for stallions, mares and geldings, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book, which have won their NPS affiliated M&M Ridden class at the qualifying show (with the exception of Working Hunter Pony, First Ridden and Leading Rein classes).
- b) Rider any age, except stallions (see rules in section A 3.2)
- c) The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter the championship but only ponies owned by NPS Qualifying or Life members can receive the Silver Medal Rosette and qualify for the final at which a Gold Medal is presented. (see section A 1.3)
- d) The Silver Medal Rosette goes to the Champion, if owned by an NPS member. If the Champion is not owned by an NPS member the Silver Medal Rosette goes to the Reserve if it is owned by an NPS member. Silver Medal Rosette to go no lower than first Reserve (third) provided it is owned by an NPS Member.
- e) The qualification goes to the Champion, if owned by an NPS member and not already qualified for the M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship final. If the Champion is not owned by an NPS Member or has already qualified then the qualification goes to the Reserve Champion, if owned by an NPS member, unless he has already qualified. Qualification to go no lower than first Reserve (third) provided it is owned by an NPS Member
- f) Ponies qualifying in Scotland can go forward to either the Scotland M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship final or the Silver Medal Rosette Championship final at the NPS Summer Championship show. Ponies qualifying outside Scotland go forward to the Silver Medal Rosette Championship final at the NPS Summer Championship show.

The NPS/TEAM HARVEY Working Hunter Pony Training Stakes (Open to M&M and Plaited ponies)

- a. Open to mares, geldings and stallions four year old and over, in possession of an equine passport but no specific registration or breed society criteria. Plaited ponies to a maximum of 153cm. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.
- b. These classes are designed to encourage the pony/rider to perform stylishly. Class 1 – Height of fences 46cms to 53cms Class 2 – Height of fences 53cms to 69cms Class 3 – Height of fences 69cms to 84cms Class 4 – Height of fences 84cms to 99cms Method of Judging
- c. Ponies will enter the ring individually and jump a course designed to produce a maximum of 10 jumping efforts.
- d. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 5.
- e. 5 penalties will be incurred for each pole down or run out. Three refusals at any one fence will result in elimination. (A maximum of 50 marks will be awarded for a clear round). #
- f. Fall of pony or rider will result in elimination.
- g. There will be no mark awarded for conformation but a mark of 20 will be awarded for overall impression at the completion of each round.
- h. In the event of a tie the overall impression mark will determine the final placings.
- i. Rider any age, except stallions (see rules in section A 3.2). Riders may only ride one pony in each class.
- j. Ponies may be shown in any suitable bridle
- k. The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition or to qualify but the owner must be a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final. Qualification for this series runs from 1st October to 31st March each year.
- l. The three highest placed ponies which have not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify for the final at the NPS Spring Festival.

NPS/STEVENSON BROTHERS ROCKING HORSES M&M First Ridden Working Hunter Pony Class 63

- a) Mares and geldings four years old or over, not exceeding 128 cms, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Fences Height: Min - 47 cms (1'6") Max - 53 cms (1'9") Spread: Max - 47 cms (1'6")
- b) Rider over 5 years but under 12 years (see rules in section A 3.2). Riders who have qualified for the (Horse of the Year Show or RIHS) M&M WHP Championship before 1st January in the current year, on any pony, are not eligible. Riders may only ride one pony in this class.
- c) The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition but only ponies owned by NPS Qualifying or Life members can qualify for the final.
- d) The highest placed pony, owned by an NPS member, in each class goes forward to the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than third place.
- e) Ponies may not be ridden side saddle.
- f) The course will consist of a minimum of seven fences, one of which must be a spread. A change of direction must be included. If a hazard is included, it will be numbered and judged as a fence.
- g) See section A 4.7 for judging and marking criteria for working hunter pony classes.
- h) Ponies MUST NOT be asked to gallop.
- i) To be shown in any suitable bridle.
- j) All ponies forward for final judging must be stripped.

PONIES ASSOCIATION (UK) Classes 53 to 56

- Classes 53 to 56 are to be judged according to the rules and regulations of Ponies Association (UK).
- Owners must be Adult/Life Members; Riders must be current Ponies UK Annual Members.

- Ponies must be currently registered with Ponies (UK) before time of entry in order to compete in these classes. Open to Mountain & Moorland Ridden Stallions (Intermediate classes only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books or Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D.
- The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the Ponies (UK) RIHS Young Riders or Amateur classes at the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead in July 2019.

Ponies (UK) Amateur Rule

- (A) Amateur Status** – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:
- Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.
 - Receive remuneration for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or Riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
 - Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.
 - Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, **or act as a Brand Ambassador or Supported Person, in any** showing classes, Ponies (UK) or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned.
 - A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in **any** Open classes, Ponies (UK) or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working Show Horse and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show. **The above Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and only ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership.**
 - On the day when an Exhibit is competing in an Amateur class, Professionals are not allowed to ride or work-in the relevant animal. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
- (B) Amateur Owner/Rider.** Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur, (the Rider need not be the Owner of the Horse). This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. **No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.**
- (C) Amateur Home Produced.** Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. **No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse**

RIHS BSPA COLOURED Classes 34 to 37

- Classes 34 to 37 are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead on Tuesday 23rd July 2019. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules which can be downloaded from www.bspa.online.com. All horses and ponies must be registered and all owners and riders must be BSPA members prior to the show. Riders age taken from the 1st January in the current year. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must have a current JMB height certificate.
- **NEW WORDING** Competitors qualifying at this show for the Royal International Horse Show 23rd – 28th July 2019 must submit their entries by recorded delivery post with full payment within 48 hours of qualifying to The Showing Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex, RH17 5NU. Schedules and entry forms can be downloaded at www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-and-results/the-longines-royal-international-horse-show/.
- All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA or hold a BSPA showing permit (contact BSPA for Stallion Showing Permit information) for 2019 and have a BSPA stallion ID card, and wear a BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 years old may exhibit a stallion in any class. No competitors / Owners/Horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2019 membership of BSPA and a RIHS qualification card.
- **Membership/Horse Registrations must be in place before you enter classes.**
- Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd will qualify from each class. No competitor lower than 3rd may qualify. BSPA Office – 01354 638726. bspashows@gmail.com.
- Skewbald & Piebald horse/ponies only.
- Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class will qualify for amateur and junior supreme championship finals to be held at the **BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2019** at the College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe, Beds. Cards to be

shown and qualification cards signed. All Champion and Reserve Champion winners qualify for the BSPA Star Championship at WCC.

3) All competitors take part at their OWN RISK and are expected to exercise due care at all times and obey all notices displayed.

4) The SWPA recommends that all exhibitors should have adequate personal sports insurance.

5) All shows affiliated to SWPA MUST have adequate Third-Party insurance.

6) All accidents/incidents/falls should be reported to the Secretary of the individual show.

7) Exhibitors: Exhibitors may not knowingly exhibit any Pony/Horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, or his/her immediate family or his/her employer, or from which financial gain has been made in the last two years. An exhibitor may not show an equine in a competition class judged by any member of his/her immediate family, may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced an equine within two years of the current year date, and may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition within two years of the current year date. Exhibitors in both Ridden and In-Hand classes should wear NO Face and or Body Jewellery

8) Equines: All Ridden Ponies MUST be 4 years old & over. All Colts / Stallions two years old and over must be in possession of a current license, (unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society) and adequately bitted. All Stallions MUST wear 'Stallion Badges' in all showing classes In-Hand Stallions / Colts may NOT be led by any Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Reins that restrict the natural movement of a pony/horse MUST not be used in the ring. Snaffle Bridles only should be used in Lead Rein, First Ridden, Novice Ridden & Novice Ridden Working Hunter Classes. 'Wilkie Bits' may not be used as Snaffles and may not be used as part of a double bridle. (Details of acceptable Snaffle Bridles can be obtained from the (Secretary) Mountain & Moorland ponies MUST be shown in their natural state and trimming MUST comply with the respective Pure Breed Society Stud Books. Mountain & Moorland ponies and Part Breds must be registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies and registration numbers to be stated on the entry forms and when entered on the day, (unless otherwise stated on the individual class). These conditions also apply to horses/ponies entered as Pure Bred, Part Bred & Anglo Arabs. Mares with foals at foot MUST have attained their 4th birthday. All foals being shown MUST be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show. No Foals to be Clipped, Lunged or shown Bitted. Mountain & Moorland Foals must be eligible for entry into their respective Pure Breed Society Stud Books. SWPA recommend all equines are vaccinated against Equine Influenzas. We recommend Affiliated Shows check passports of all equines attending their show, and make exhibitors aware of any additional rules applied by the venues they use.

- Riders / Handlers: Any Pony **Stallion** not exceeding 138cms or Small Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions may NOT be ridden by juniors who have NOT attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year at any show affiliated to South West Pony Association. Stallions exceeding 138cms or Large Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions may NOT be ridden by Juniors who have NOT attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current at any show affiliated to South West Pony Association. (unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society)
- **Junior Handlers** of equines in all In-Hand classes, aged 14 years and under should wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats.
- All **Children** MUST have attained their 3rd birthday by 1st January in the current year before competing in ANY ridden classes and must comply with the upper limit of the class entered and be prepared to supply a copy of their birth certificate if requested.
- Riders MUST be within the **correct age limits** for the type of Horse/Pony ridden for the qualification to be valid.
- In Ridden Classes, if a **rider falls off** at any time whilst in the ring, both pony/horse and rider MUST leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part in the class.
- Exhibitors in both Ridden and In-Hand classes should wear NO Face and or Body Jewellery
- Correct British Standard Headgear conforming to European VG1 and/or PAS015 both with BSI Kitemarking or current standards to be worn at all times when mounted, with chinstraps from 3 points on the hat fastened.
- NO Spurs to worn in any ridden class
- Showing Canes MUST not exceed 30".

10) Judges: The Judges' decision is final.

11) Welfare of Equines: If an equine is deemed to be being mistreated in any way whilst at the show ground, the person or persons responsible may be asked to leave the show ground and may be reported to the authorities. The SWPA is also supporting the appropriate size/weight of rider for the equine they are riding.

12) Behaviour: Behaviour by an exhibitor or his/her servants deemed unsporting or unreasonable, may be requested to leave the showground.

Any animal which in the opinion of the judge, is deemed out of control will be requested to leave the ring and/or the show ground.

Any exhibitors or their servants seen using social media to air disputes will be requested to remove all their exhibits from the showground and forfeit any entry fees paid.

13) Objections: We advise that objections be made in writing to the secretary of your show within 30 minutes of the completion of the relevant class and accompanied with a fee of £10.00 (refundable if the objection is upheld)
