This event is a qualifier for The British Connemara Pony Society's (BCPS) Eventing Championships to be held on 10th/11th September 2022 at Swalcliffe Park, Oxfordshire. To qualify you must be placed in the top 10 of must your section or have a double clear.

To compete at the championship, the owner of the pony needs to be an Adult/Junior or Performance Member of the British Connemara Pony Society. Ponies must be pure, part-bred, or over-height Connemara's, which are registered or over-stamped on the BCPS database. The pony must be in the correct ownership. Body protectors 2009 & above labels are mandatory for XC. Air jackets can be worn over a body protector. Medical armbands are not compulsory but highly recommended.

**COVID 19:** The organisers have assessed the risks of Covid 19 in line with British Riding Clubs guidelines and have taken measures to ensure compliance with current legislation and guidelines.
