Rules

- All horses competing under saddle <u>must</u> be at the age of 4 or above.
- The age of rider will be taken from the 1st January 2017
- The judges decisions are final
- No abuse of any kind (towards organisers or horses/ponies) will be tolerated on the grounds.
- Instructions given by any Official must be obeyed.
- A correctly fitted and current standard riding hat (PAS015) must be worn at all times by anyone mounted on a horse/pony.
- Any animal not under control or in any way constituting a danger may be asked to leave the ring or showground.
- Owners enter their horses/ponies at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to Broads Equestrian Centre or the show organisers.
- No claim or correspondence will be entered in respect of any claim arising from any incident, accident or injury to competitors, spectators, their property, servants or horses in connection with or arising out of attendance of a show held at Broads Equestrian Centre.
- Broads Equestrian Centre reserves the right to refuse entries without stating any reason.
- No refunds of entries or hiring will be made unless a vet certificate can be produced.
- Only horses/ponies that are entered into an event may use the facilities. If you have a horse/pony that you are bringing on a competition day but not competing, please advise the show organiser and payment of £10 hire charge will be made.
- Any droppings must be cleared from the surfaces and the car park.
- Strictly no mucking out of lorries and trailers on the show ground.
- No rubbish to be left on the show ground, please use the bins provided or take your litter home.
- Dogs must be kept on leads and in control at all times while on the show ground. Please clean up after your dogs, failure to do so will incur being asked to leave.
- At **NO** time will any unauthorised person entre the livery yard.
- Strictly no Lunging on the grass areas or car park You will be asked to leave the showground.
- There will be a 10 minute call for classes, **No** competitor may enter any class at the ring side.
- No entries will be taken on the day.
- There is a limit of 12 entries per class

PLEASE NOTE: Broads Equestrian Centre is situated on the A146 which is a busy road, we 'ADVISE' all traffic on leaving the grounds to turn left.

- 4. In hand Traditional/ Hogged Cob
- 5. In Hand Rare and Foreign Breeds
- 6. In hand Part bred
- 7. In hand Coloureds
- 8. Novice and Young Handler (Hander not to have been placed 1st at any show before this date)
- 9. In hand Thoroughbred and retired racehorse
- 10. In hand Veteran (Horse/Pony over 15 years of age)
- 11. In hand Native breeds
 (Include M&M breeds, Shire, Clydesdale, Suffolk Punch, Hackney and Thoroughbreds)

In hand Championship

1st and 2nd places from classes 1 - 11 Champion and Reserve Champion go through to supreme of the day.

- 14. Ridden Coloureds
- 15. Ridden Thoroughbred
- 16. Ridden Cob
- 17. Ridden Novice (Neither Rider or horse to have been placed 1st at any show before this date)
- 18. Ridden Hacks and Riding Horse
- 19. Ridden Foreign and Rare breeds
- 20. Ridden Hunter Horse, pony/ Hunter Types (Lead rein permitted)
