Times: Available 2 days prior to competition, will be emailed to address stated on entry form, published on the Comeytrowe Facebook page, or available on 07837376823 between 6pm-8pm.

Rules and Regulations:

1. No refunds will be given after the closing date.
2. Hats must be worn at all times when mounted. The minimum standard is EN 1384 or PAS015. A hat with a prefix of ASTM or SEI is considered to offer more protection than EN 1384.
3. Correct riding dress must be worn by all competitors.
4. Competition run under British Dressage rules.
5. In the event of classes being oversubscribed a waiting list will be kept.
6. The Judges' decision is final.
7. No lunging allowed in the warm up area.
8. Horses must not be tied up outside lorry/trailer and left unattended or
9. tied up to any fencing.
10. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
11. Please pick up any droppings and take your litter home.

Comeytrove Points Championship Rules

At each qualifying show in this series, points will be awarded to horse/rider combinations based on the percentages they achieve in any class throughout the series. Each test percentage will be divided by 2 to give the points total for each test. (e.g. a combination scoring 60%, will be awarded 30 points for that test.)

Points winners will be decided from the accumulation of results from all qualifying shows and will be presented at the Championship show. Points places will be awarded 1st – 6th. There will also be a separate overall under 16 points champion. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided on collective marks.

Trophies to winners and further prizes in kind will be awarded to 6th place.

Comeytrove Championship Show Qualification

Any horse/rider combination achieving a score of 58% or higher will gain qualification to the championship show, in the level in which they qualified. If the winning score in any class does not reach 58%, 1st and 2nd prize winners of that class will qualify for the championship show.

There will be a series Champion for each level decided by the results of the classes at the championship show.

Rosettes to 6th place.

Prizes for the Championship show will be announced in the Championship Show schedule.

Entries for the Championship show will follow usual entry procedures and schedules will be available nearer the date.
