The correct standard of hat must be worn with a chin strap at all times when mounted. If you wish to wear a Non standard hat, you must sign a disclaimer at the secretarys office/tent

Horses/ponies under the age of 4 years must not be ridden on the showground.

Dogs must be kept on a lead.

No mucking out of horseboxes on the showground.

Please take your rubbish home with you or use the bins provided – horses will be turned out in the fields the day after show.

Stallions/ colts welcome but must be handled by competent person over the age of 16

All complaints must be made in writing and accompanied by £15.00 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.

FERRYBRIDGE SCHEDULE

Ring 1 Starts 9.30am

- Class 1** **Best Condition**— Horse and Ponies judged seperatly if sufficient numbers
Class 2 **Best Cob/Heavy Type** - Horse/pony, hogged, plaited or natural
Class 3 **Handsome Horse** - open to geldings/stallions
Class 4 **Best Coloured Horse/pony** - piebald, skewbald, roan, dun, palomino, cremello
Class 5 **Veteran horse/pony** - 15 years and over
Class 6 **In Hand Gelding or Stallion** - Horses and Ponies judged seperatly if sufficient Numbers
Class 7 **Part Bred horse/pony** - Can be plaited, hogged, natural
Class 8 **Condition Regardless Flaws** - Judged purely on confirmation and going, regardless of any scars or blemishes

In Hand Championship for Classes 1-8 and 17-32 for all winners

There will be a break for the judge prior to the ridden classes commencing. Ridden classes will not commence before 12.30pm

- Class 9** **First Ridden up to 13.2** - Inc. lead rein, (must be attached to noseband). Child 12 yrs and under, to be ridden in a snaffle Equifest Qualifier see oveleaf
Class 10 **Absolute Beginners** - Open to horse/pony and rider any age - Inc lead rein, walk, trot no group canter and canter optional in Individual show (lead rein must be attached to noseband)
Class 11 **Novice Ridden** - Open to horses and ponies, combination not to have won a 1st previous season. No group canter, no lead rein
Class 12 **Ridden Veteran** - Horse or pony to be 15yrs and over
Class 13 **Best Ridden Pony**- open to all types
Class 14 **Best Ridden Coloured** - as per in hand class
Class 15 **Equitation** - Class will be split between junior and senior if sufficient turnout. No whips, Spurs and in a snaffle
Class 16 **Best Ridden Horse**

Ridden Championship for Classes 9-16 and 25-32 for all winners -

- Class 17** **Youngstock** - 1, 2, 3 years old in hand
Class 18 **Best handler**—may be split between junior and seniors if sufficient Numbers
Class 19 **Bonny Pony**
Class 20 **Pretty Mare or Filly**
Class 21 **Mountain and Moorland**
Class 22 **In Hand Mare** - Horses and Ponies judged seperatly if sufficient Numbers
Class 23 **Shetland in hand** - Full or miniature
Class 24 **In Hand Novice** - Combination not to have won 3 1st places in previous season

In Hand Championship for Classes 1-8 and 17-32 for all winners

There will be a 30min break for the judge prior to the ridden classes commencing. Ridden classes will not commence before 12.30pm

- Class 25** **Promising Newcomer** - Open to horses/ponies that are 4,5,&6
Class 26 **Mountain and Moorland** - open to large and small breeds - class will be split if sufficient numbers
Class 27 **Open Ridden Hunter**
Class 28 **Ridden Purebred** - Excludes mountain and moorland
Class 29 **Ridden Cob/Heavy type** - Open to any Horse /Pony to be shown hogged or natural
Class 30 **Ideal Partners** - Open to horses/ponies judged on manners, performance and compatibility
Class 31 **Ridden Part bred** - open to horse or pony
Class 32 **Concourse de elegance**
